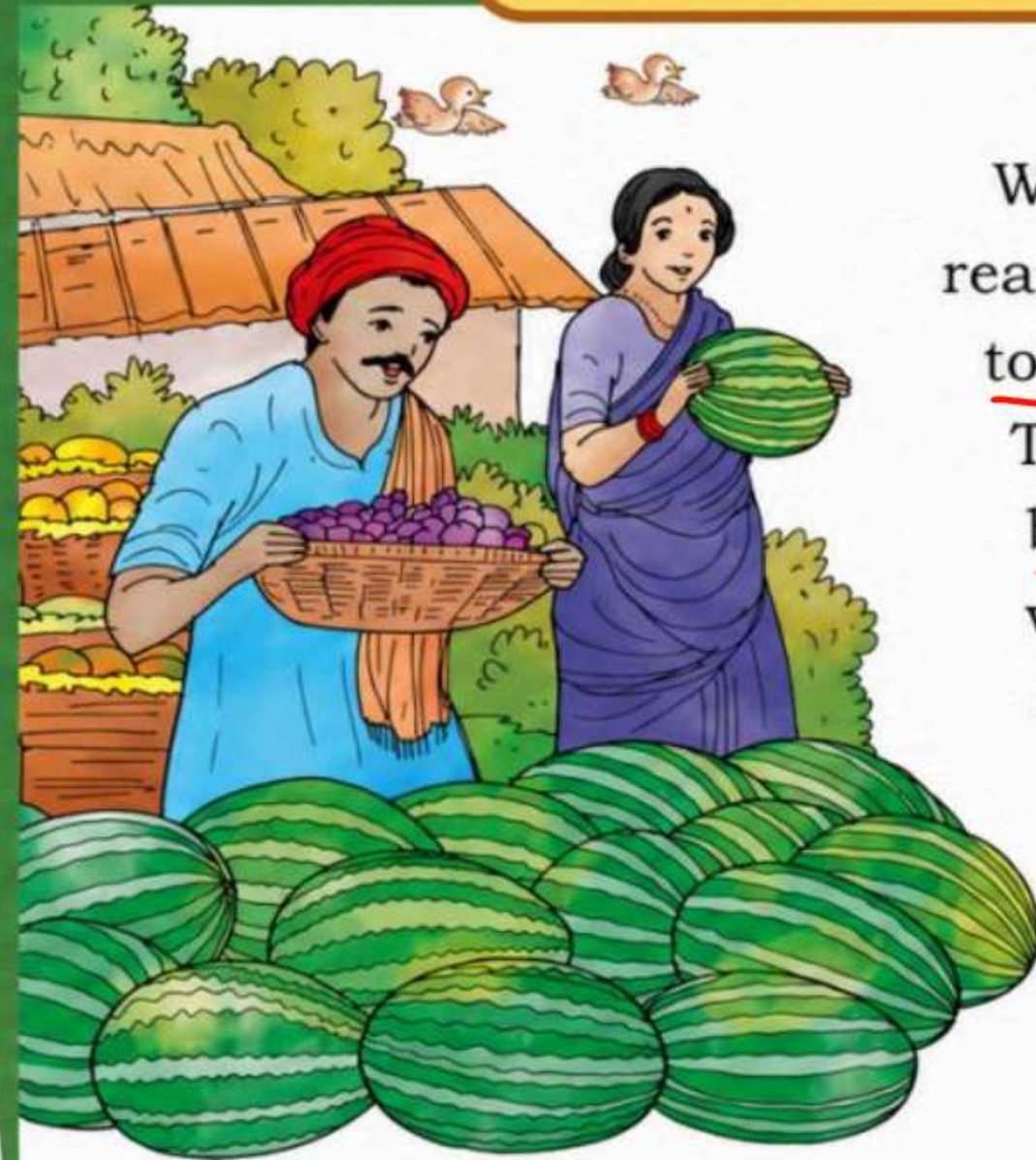


Chapter 8. Thank God!
