Context: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has announced a \$1-million prize for the successful decipherment of the ancient Indus Valley script.

- ❖ Flourished around 2600–1900 BCE in regions now in India and Pakistan.
- ❖ Known for its advanced urban planning, trade networks, and undeciphered script.
- ❖ Thousands of inscriptions discovered on seals, pottery, and other artifacts.

Challenges in Decipherment:

- ❖ Inscriptions are typically short, with fewer than 30 symbols.
- ❖ No consensus on linguistic structure or affiliation.

Potential Linguistic Links:

- ❖ Many researchers hypothesize links between the Indus script and the Dravidian language family, making the initiative culturally significant for Tamil Nadu.

Income Inequality in India: Trends and Insights

Why in News Recent data analysis has revealed significant trends in income inequality in India, particularly during and after the pandemic. The insights highlight the changing dynamics of wealth distribution, with the top 10% and top 1% seeing fluctuations in their income shares.

Key Trends

- ❖ **Top 10 Per Cent:** Despite a slight decrease to 30.6% in 2022-23, the top 10% of earners continue to hold a substantial share of the national income, indicating entrenched wealth concentration.
- ❖ **Bottom 10 Per Cent:** The pandemic exacerbated vulnerabilities, with their share of income plummeting to 1.1% in 2020-21, the lowest recorded in the dataset. However, a modest recovery to 2.4% in 2022-23 offers hope for gradual improvement.
- ❖ **Top 1 Per Cent:** This group experienced significant growth in income share during the pandemic, peaking at 9.0% in 2020-21, before a slight decline to 7.3% in 2022-23.

Empowering Healthcare: CM Dr. Mohan Yadav Flags Off 66 Mobile Medical Units

Why in news : On 6 January, the Madhya Pradesh government, under the PM Janman Abhiyan, launched 66 Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) to provide essential healthcare services in remote and underserved regions.

- ❖ The program aims to cover 1,268 villages across 87 development blocks in 21 districts, benefiting approximately 3.12 lakh people.

- ❖ Chief Minister Dr. Yadav emphasized that strengthening healthcare infrastructure is the state government's highest priority.
- ❖ The recruitment of over 46,000 healthcare personnel has already been approved, with directions to expedite the process.
