St James's Park, London was announced as the location for the UK's national memorial to Queen Elizabeth II.

- Location Selection-The site was chosen due to its historical significance and personal connection to the late Queen, as well as its proximity to the ceremonial route of The Mall
- Memorial Purpose-CReflect Queen Elizabeth II's extraordinary life of service and provide a space for pause and reflection.

Site Details

- The Memorial will encompass St James's Park near Marlborough Gate.
- Includes surrounding land and the pathway leading to the lake, including the Blue Bridge.

Committee Involvement

 Established by the UK Government and Royal Household in 2023.

Randhir Singh

Why in the news?

Randhir Singh became the first Indian to be elected as the president of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) during the 44th General Assembly of the OCA in New Delhi.

- * Tenure- from 2024 till 2028.
- A five-time Olympic shooter, Randhir previously served as an International Olympic Committee (IOC) member from 2001 to 2014.

Randhir Singh's Sports Achievements and Honors

Randhir Singh competed in four Asian Games between 1978 and 1994.

- Won an individual gold medal in trap shooting in 1978.
- Secured a bronze medal in a trap in 1982.
- Won a team silver medal in trap in 1986.

He also competed at the 1978 Commonwealth Games in Edmonton, Canada.

- In 1979, he was awarded the prestigious Arjuna Award.
- He was also conferred with the Maharaja Ranjit Singh Award in 1979.

About the Olympic Council of Asia

The Olympic Council of Asia is the governing body for sports in Asia. It is recognised by the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

Deepali Thapa

Why in the news?

Indian boxer Deepali Thapa has made history by becoming the first-ever Asian Schoolgirl Champion in Al Ain, UAE.

With her win, India has won seven out of 15 women's titles at the Asian Championships. In the 33 kg weight category, Thapa defeated Ukraine's Liudmyla Vasylchenko in the final.



Paris Paralympics 2024

Why in the news?

India achieved a record 29 medals at the Paris Paralympics 2024, including seven gold, nine silver, and 13 bronze. In the Tokyo Paralympics in 2021, India finished with 19 medals.

Dates: August 28 - September 8, 2024

- Host City: Paris
- Indian Contingent: 84 para-athletes, largest contingent in history.
- Events: India will compete in 12 out of 22 sports.

Opening Ceremony Flag Bearers:

- ❖ Sumit Antil Tokyo Paralympics gold medallist in F64 javelin throw
- Bhagyashri Jadhav Asian Para Games silver medallist in shot put (F34 category)

India's medals won in the Paris
Paralympics by sport:

- * Athletics: 4 gold; 6 silver; 7 bronze
- Badminton: 1 gold; 2 silver; 2 bronze
- Shooting: 1 gold; 1 silver; 2 bronze
- * Archery: 1 gold; 1 bronze
- Judo: 1 bronze

India will finish the Paralympics on the 16th position in the medal tally with 29 medals. China is on the first position with a whooping 216 medals followed by Great Britain (120) and the USA (102).

Why in the news?

International Literacy Day 2024 is celebrated annually on September 8.

- The theme for International Literacy Day 2024 is 'Promoting multilingual education: Literacy for mutual understanding and peace."
- International Literacy Day was established by UNESCO on October 26, 1966, during its 14th General Conference. The first celebration took place in 1967.







News in Short:

- Senior bureaucrat Tuhin Kanta Pandey was designated as the new finance secretary.
- Aryna Sabalenka (Belarusian) beats Jessica Pegula to win maiden US Open women's title. This victory marks Sabalenka's third career Grand Slam title.
- England's versatile all-rounder Moeen Ali has officially announced his retirement from international cricket.

- The Room Next Door, a proeuthanasia film, won the prestigious Golden Lion award for best film at the Venice Film Festival. The film stars Tilda Swinton and Julianne Moore and was directed by Pedro Almodóvar.
- The backward class and extremely backward class welfare department has approved two crore 58 lakh 60 thousand for increasing facilities in Jannayak Karpuri Thakur hostels Patna. The amount has been sent to all districts except Siwan and Khagaria.
