# **New Guidelines for Coaching centers:**

The Central Consumer Protection Authority has issued new guidelines for coaching centers to stop misleading advertisements.

#### **Key Points**

- According to the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA), coaching centers can no longer make false claims that may mislead consumers.
- CCPA has issued 45 notices to various coaching centers for misleading advertisements. And has imposed a fine of Rs 54 lakh 60 thousand on 18 coaching institutes and directed them to stop misleading advertisements.
- These guidelines will be applicable to all institutes, coaching centers and organizations providing academic support, education, guidance and tuition services.
- Enforcement and Penalties: Any violation of these guidelines will be treated as a violation of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019. And the Central Authority will have the power to take strict action against the offenders.

# Highlights of the guidelines:

- Coaching centers cannot make false promises about their courses, their duration, faculty, fee structure, selection rate, examination ranking and refund policy.
- No coaching center can guarantee job security and salary hike.
- Coaching centers will not be able to use the name, photo and testimonials of toppers without written consent. If a

- coaching center wants to use the name of a topper for its promotion, then it will have to take written permission from the candidate after his selection.
- Coaching centers will have to provide all the necessary information related to their courses to the students.
- These guidelines do not apply to counseling, sports and creative activities.
- Coaching centers will have to provide information about their services, facilities, resources and infrastructure.
- Coaching centers will have to tell whether their course is recognised by any authority like AICTE, UGC or not.







# Supreme Court's instruction on Bulldozer Action

The Supreme Court has given its verdict on the bulldozer action and issued guidelines.

#### **Key Points:**

- The Supreme Court has given a historic verdict on bulldozer action and has banned arbitrary action.
- The court has termed the action of arbitrarily running bulldozers without following the prescribed legal procedure as lawlessness and anarchy.

# Key points of the guidelines

- According to the court, at least 15 days' notice must be given before demolishing a house or any property.
- After giving the order to demolish the illegal construction, the concerned person should be given 15 days time so that he can demolish or remove it himself.
- No property will be demolished without show cause notice.
- The notice will include the reason for demolition of the property, the time of its hearing and information about the officer.
- The demolition of the property should be video recorded. It should be kept safe and the report of the action should be submitted to the Municipal Commissioner
- After issuing the order of bulldozer action, time should be given to appeal against it.

- These guidelines do not apply to illegal encroachments, such as illegal construction on roads or river banks.
- Notice will be sent to the owner of the construction through a registered post and will also be pasted on the wall.
- The Collector and District Magistrate will also be informed.
- The order will be uploaded on the digital portal.
- If any officer violates the guidelines, he will get the property reconstructed at his own expense and will also pay compensation.

# Coastal Defence Exercise 'Sea Vigil-24'

- The Indian Navy will conduct the 4th edition of the 'Pan-India' Coastal Defence Exercise 'Sea Vigil-24' on 20 and 21 November 2024.
- 6 ministries and 21 organizations /agencies will be involved in the exercise.
- This year, for the first time, officers from the National Security Council Secretariat will also be part of the Indian Navy-led CDSRE teams.
- Main Focus: The exercise will focus on strengthening the security of critical coastal infrastructure including coastal assets such as ports, oil rigs, single point moorings, cable landing points and coastal population.



- Aim: The aim of the exercise is to enhance awareness on maritime safety among coastal communities.
- Conceptualized in the year 2018, Sea Vigil was designed to validate and enhance the measures adopted to strengthen coastal defense following the 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks.
