India Internet Governance Forum (IIGF) 2024

The India Internet Governance Forum (IIGF) 2024 was held on December 9-10, 2024, at the Bharat Mandapam Convention Center, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.

Key Points

- It is supported by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) and the National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI).
- This initiative aims to explore critical aspects of Internet governance, foster meaningful dialogue, and highlight India's leadership in the global digital landscape.
- This was the fourth edition (previous editions took place in 2021, 2022, and 2023) of the forum.
- The theme of this edition was "Innovating Internet Governance for India".
- The forum focused on bridging the digital divide, enhancing trust and safety in the online environment, and leveraging advanced technologies for nation-building while emphasizing the need for a secure, inclusive, and ethically governed Internet.

20th IISS Manama Dialogue

External Affairs Minister (EAM) Dr. S. Jaishankar recently participated in the 20th IISS Manama Dialogue.

Key Points

It is an international security summit held in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

- It is organized by the International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS).
- It is a unique forum for ministers, policymakers and decision-makers to debate the Middle East's most pressing foreign-policy, defence and security challenges.
- It has been held annually since 2004.
- The theme for 2024 dialogue was: Middle East Leadership in Shaping Regional Prosperity and Security.

Short News- Uttar Pradesh

- ❖ On 9th December 2024, the first validation flight successfully landed at the Noida International Airport (NIA), marking a significant milestone in its journey toward operational readiness. An Airbus A320 plane from Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI) landed at Noida International Airport, also known as the Jewar airport. The validation flight is an important element for the aerodrome licensing process, a key requirement for running commercial operations.
- Chief minister Yogi Adityanath launched the Ayushman Vaya Vandana Card scheme from Gorakhpur. The scheme aims to provide free medical treatment worth up to ₹5 lakh to persons aged 70 and above.
- Nationwide, Maharashtra leads with 36.8 lakh women ITR filers, followed by Gujarat with 22.5 lakh and Uttar Pradesh with 20.4 lakh in the assessment year 2023-24.



- As per the education ministry, over 1.1 million children across India have been identified as 'Out of School' (OoSC) for the 2024-25 academic year. Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, and Assam reported high numbers among the total 1,170,404 children who remain out of school.
 - Uttar Pradesh contributes the most with 784,228 OoSC children, followed by Jharkhand with 65,070 and Assam with 63,848
