# 85th All India Presiding Officers Conference

# Why in the news?

The 85th session of the All India Presiding Officers' Conference (AIPOC) will be organized in Patna in Bihar on the 20th and 21st January 2025.

Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla will chair the conference and Bihar Legislature will Co-host.

- > 54 Presiding officers which includes Speakers, Chairman of the Legislative Houses will participate in the conference and 31 secretaries of the state legislatures will take part in the conference. 60 officials from Lok Sabha and Seven from Rajya Sabha will attend the apex body meeting
- The theme of the two-day programme is based on the 75th glorious journey of the Indian Constitution.
- \* The conference will discuss the contribution of Parliament and state legislatures in the empowerment of constitutional values in the context of the 75th anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution.

#### About the AIPOC:

- It is the apex body of the Legislatures in India which is a platform for sharing best practices and innovative ideas among all legislative assemblies and councils under the guidance of Lok Sabha.
- The conference is being organised in Bihar after a long hiatus of 43 years, which was organised last time in 1982. This is the third time that Bihar is hosting AIPOC in Patna.

#### Mission Mausam

## Why in the news?

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the 'Mission Mausam' on 14th January 2025.

- It was launched as part of the celebrations marking the 150th Foundation Day of the India Meteorological Department (IMD).
- Objective: Making India a weatherready and climate-smart nation.

## Advantages:

- It is expected to benefit a wide array of sectors, including agriculture, disaster management, defence, aviation, energy, and health.
- Additionally, it will support datadriven decision-making in urban planning, transport, and environmental monitoring.

#### About the Mission:

It was approved by the Union Cabinet in September 2024, with a budget of Rs 2,000 crore over two years.

- The project will primarily be implemented by the India Meteorological Department, the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, and the National Centre for Medium-Range Weather Forecasting.
- \* It focuses on enhancing atmospheric observations with next-generation radars, satellites, and high-performance computers while improving the understanding of weather and climate processes.
- The mission will also provide critical air quality data to aid long-term weather management and intervention strategies.

## India Meteorological Department

- It is India's national meteorological service. It was established in 1875 by the Government of India.
- IMD's headquarters are located at Mausam Bhawan in New Delhi.
- It functions under the Ministry of Earth Sciences.

#### Sonamarg Tunnel

## Why in the news?

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated and dedicated the prestigious Sonamarg Tunnel to the nation, in Central Kashmir's Ganderbal district on 13th January 2025.

The work on the tunnel project began in May 2015 and was completed in 2024..

#### About the tunnel:

- It will significantly reduce the travel time to just 20-25 minutes between Gagangeer and Sonamarg in Ganderbal district.
- It is equipped with cutting-edge technologies that provide real-time updates and seamless connectivity for users.

# \* Significance:

- The opening of the tunnel is a major step towards making the Ladakh region accessible by road throughout the year.
- This engineering marvel is poised to unlock the full potential of the region's trade and tourism sectors.



- The tunnel will boost domestic and international tourism in Sonamarg while providing all-weather connectivity between Sonamarg and Gagangeer that leads to the approach road towards under construction Zojila tunnel.
- This will increase socio-economic development throughout the region including Kargil and Leh districts.
