RBI forms new advisory committee

Why in the news?

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced the setting up of a Standing External Advisory Committee (SEAC), which will evaluate applications for Universal Banks as well as Small Finance Banks (SFBs) on 21 Jan 2025.

The tenure of the SEAC will be for three years.

Indonesia's Mt Ibu




Why in the news?

Manipur, Meghalaya and Tripura celebrate
Statehood Day



Why in the news?

Every year on January 21, the northeastern states of Manipur, Meghalaya, and Tripura celebrate their Statehood Day, marking the historic moment they attained full statehood under the North Eastern Region (Reorganization) Act of 1971.

- Manipur and Tripura: These princely states merged with India in 1949. Initially granted Union Territory status in 1956, they aspired for full statehood, which was achieved on 21st January 1972.
- Meghalaya: Originally part of Assam, Meghalaya gained autonomy through the Assam Reorganisation (Meghalaya) Act, of 1969. It became a full-fledged state in 1972.
- The northeastern region of India, often referred to as the "Seven Sisters," comprises seven states: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, and Tripura.

The government has introduced 'Entity Locker,' a new digital platform aimed at streamlining the management and verification of business and organizational documents.

- Developed by the National eGovernance Division (NeGD) under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), this secure, cloud-based platform caters to a diverse range of entities, including corporations, micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), trusts, startups, and societies.
- Entity Locker leverages advanced technology to seamlessly integrate with various government and regulatory systems.

Key features:

- Real-time access to government databases, consent-based mechanisms for secure information sharing, Aadhaar-authenticated role-based access, and legally valid digital signatures.
- Users are also provided with 10 GB of encrypted cloud storage for secure document handling.

Edelman Trust Barometer 2025

Why in the news?

India slipped to **3rd place** in overall trust, behind China (1st) and Indonesia (2nd).

- The barometer ranks trust in government, business, media, and NGOs.
- India is ranked 13th globally in trust in companies headquartered in the country.
- Top Countries for Corporate Trust: Canada ranks 1st, followed by Japan, Germany, the UK, France, and the US.
- Countries Ahead of India: Mexico, South Africa, Saudi Arabia, China, and Brazil rank higher in trust in companies.
- According to the report, lowerincome groups are less trustworthy than their richer counterparts.

News in Short

- The Union Agriculture Ministry has started the first-ever survey to know the pattern of edible oil consumption in the country.
 - This survey started on January 9 and will continue till February 23, 2025.

- The Election Commission is going to organize an international conference of election commissions from all over the world in the 76th year of its establishment.
 - About 30 representatives of election commissions of 13 countries will participate in this two-day conference to be held on 23-24 January.
- The International Society for Krishna Consciousness (ISKCON), in collaboration with the Adani Group, is delivering meals to nearly one lakh individuals daily at the ongoing Maha Kumbh Mela.
- The iconic Amrit Udyan at Rashtrapati Bhavan will be open for public viewing from February 2 to March 30, 2025.
- Angel One has announced the appointment of Ambareesh Kenghe as its Group Chief Executive Officer. Kenghe will assume the role in March 2025.
