



### US Open 2024: Jannik Sinner Beats Taylor Fritz

Jannik Sinner became the first Italian man to clinch the US Open 2024 title. The world No. 1 sealed a 6-3 6-4 7-5 win against American Taylor Fritz in the men's singles final, and then raised his arms in celebration at the Arthur Ashe Stadium.



### Aryna Sabalenka wins the 2024 US Open title.

Women's tennis singles number two seed Aryna Sabalenka has won the US Open 2024 title. Sabalenka beat Jessica Pegula of the USA in straight sets. She won 7-5, 7-5 to lift her third Grand Slam title. Before this, the Belarusian won the 2023 and 2024 Australian Open honours. This is Sabalenka's third Slam win in four attempts (2023 US Open runner-up).

Since 1967, the annual celebrations of International Literacy Day (ILD) have taken place on 8 September around the world to remind policy-makers, practitioners, and the public of the critical importance of literacy for creating more literate, just, peaceful, and sustainable society. This year, ILD will be celebrated under the theme of "Promoting multilingual education: Literacy for mutual understanding and peace".

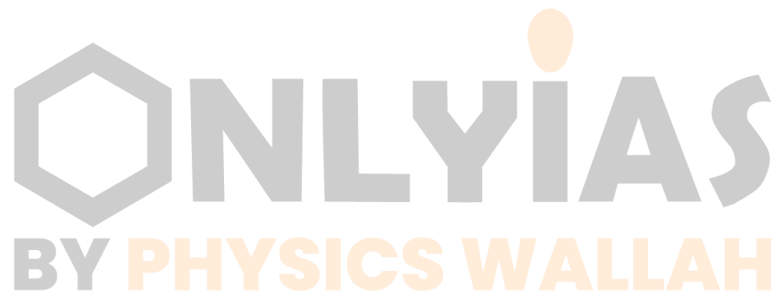
### GST Council meet on 09 September
