- Candidates who have applied as per Advertisement No.36, dated 30th December, 2023 and the Corrigendum Ref. No. AT/197, dated 31st January, 2024 published regarding the said advertisement need not to apply again. All such applications will be considered by the University.
- The Government of Maharashtra, General Administration Department, vide Government Resolution No.: BCC 2024/P.No.75/16-C dated 27th February, 2024 has newly included Socially and Educationally Backward Category. Candidates who have applied from Open / Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category as per Advertisement No.36, dated 30th December, 2023 and Corrigendum Ref. No. AT/197, dated 31st January, 2024 published in respect of the said advertisement and have Socially and Educationally Backward Category Certificate issued by Government of Maharashtra may change their category and such applications, wherein category has been changed by the Applicant from Open / Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category to Socially and Educationally Backward Category, will be considered from Socially and Educationally Backward Category only.
