Operation Sadbhav

India has launched Operation Sadbhav to provide humanitarian assistance to typhoon Yagi-affected countries – Myanmar, Laos and Vietnam.



Key point

- India sent urgent relief materials to Myanmar, Laos, and Vietnam to assist them in dealing with the impact of the major typhoon.
- These countries are reeling under massive floods after Asia's most powerful storm this year hit the three countries.
- India has been among the first responders in providing Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) to impacted countries. Operation Sadbhav is part of India's broader effort to contribute to HADR within the ASEAN region, in line with its 'Act East Policy'.

Typhoon yagi

- > Typhoon Yagi recently developed in the South China Sea.
- > It is considered the second most powerful tropical cyclone this year, after Beryl.
- Yagi originated from a lowpressure area near Palau.
- The Japan Meteorological Agency
 (JMA) named the cyclone Yagi.

Favorable Conditions for the Formation of Tropical Cyclone

- Large sea surface with temperature> 27° C;
- Presence of the Coriolis force;
- Small variations in the vertical wind speed;
- A pre-existing weak low-pressure area or low-level-cyclonic circulation and
- Upper divergence above the sea level system.
- In the South Atlantic and South-Eastern Pacific regions in tropical latitudes, cyclones do not originate because of low sea surface temperatures.



DPIIT To Launch BHASKAR

Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, DPIIT is set to launch a digital platform — BHASKAR – aimed at strengthening India's startup ecosystem.



Key point

- The Bharat Startup Knowledge Access Registry, BHASKAR initiative, is a platform designed to centralize, streamline, and enhance collaboration among key stakeholders within the entrepreneurial ecosystem.
- This initiative aligns with Government's vision to transform India into a global leader in innovation and entrepreneurship.
- BHASKAR will bridge the gap between startups, investors, mentors, and other stakeholders, allowing for seamless interaction across sectors.

4th Global Renewable Energy Investor's Meet and Expo (RE-INVEST)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the 4th Global Renewable

Energy Investor's Meet and Expo (RE-INVEST) at Mahatma Mandir,
Gandhinagar in Gujarat.



Key Point

- The 4th Global Renewable Energy Investor's Meet and Expo (RE-INVEST) is poised to highlight India's impressive progress in renewable energy manufacturing and deployment.
- It will feature a two-and-a-half-day conference attracting delegates from around the world.
- Gujarat is the host state and Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Telangana and Uttar Pradesh are participating as Partner States.
- There will be an exhibition which will showcase cutting-edge innovations from public and private sector companies, start-ups, and major industry players.
- This exhibition will underscore India's commitment to a sustainable future.



VINETRA

The Kalvari Submarine Escape Training Facility (Vinetra) was commissioned on 13 Sep 24 by Vice Admiral Rajesh Pendharkar, the Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Naval Command, at INS Satavahana, Visakhapatnam.



Key Point

- The facility, aims to enhance the escape capabilities of crew from a distressed Kalvari-class submarine, and has been indigenously designed and developed, keeping in line with the 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' initiative, highlighting India's focus on self-reliance in defence capabilities.
- The facility "Vinetra" (विनेत्र), meaning "Trainer" represents a significant step forward in building confidence among submariners, ensuring that they are equipped with the skills and training necessary to escape in case of any underwater emergency.

This training facility also reinforces the operational readiness, safety protocols and training infrastructure of the Indian Navy.

30th World Ozone Day

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change organised an event to mark the 30th World Ozone Day in New Delhi



Key Point

- The theme for World Ozone Day 2024 is "Montreal Protocol: Advancing Climate Actions" reflecting the Montreal Protocol's crucial role in both protecting the ozone layer and driving broader climate action initiatives globally.
- World Ozone Day reminds us that the ozone layer is essential for life on Earth and highlights the need for ongoing climate action to protect it for future generations.



- ❖ The ozone layer is a thin layer of ozone (O₃) molecules that is present in the Earth's stratosphere, largely between 15 to 35 kilometres above the Earth's surface.
- It plays an essential role by absorbing the sun's harmful ultraviolet (UV-B) radiation, and in return, it protects lives on Earth from the damaging effects of (UV-B) radiation.

About Montreal Protocol:

- It is an international environmental agreement adopted on September 16, 1987.
- ❖ It is the sole UN treaty universally ratified by all 197 member states, aiming to safeguard the Earth's ozone layer by phasing out the use of ozone-depleting substances, such as chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs).
- India, as a Party to the Montreal Protocol since June 1992, has been successfully implementing the Montreal Protocol.
- Objective: To protect the Earth's ozone layer by phasing out the production and consumption of ODS.
