## Smart Laboratory on Clean Rivers

The Green Strategic Partnership between the Governments of India and Denmark has fostered significant collaboration leading to the establishment of the Smart Laboratory on Clean Rivers (SLCR) in Varanasi.

## Key Points

Tripartite initiative: The alliance is a unique tripartite initiative between the Government of India (Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation), the Indian Institute of



Technology - Banaras Hindu University (IIT-BHU), and Government of Denmark, to bring excellence in small river rejuvenation and management.

- Aim: The SLCR aims to leverage the expertise of both nations to rejuvenate the river Varuna using sustainable approaches.
- Its objectives include creating a collaborative platform for government bodies, knowledge institutions and local communities to share insights and develop solutions for clean river water.
- ❖ The Indo-Danish Joint Steering Committee (JSC) is the highest forum for SLCR which provides strategic guidance and reviews progress. The Project Review Committee (PRC), with members from National Mission on Clean Ganga (NMCG), Central Water Commission (CWC), Central GroundWater Board (CGWB), IIT-BHU and Denmark's Urban Sector Counsellor, will oversee quality control at project level.

The Varuna River is a minor tributary of the Ganges River in **Uttar Pradesh**, **India**. It originates at Phulpur in the Prayagraj district and merges into the Ganges near Sarai Mohana in the Varanasi district.



## ISDra2TnpB- Tool

Indian Council of Agricultural Research and Penn State University has created a Miniature Editing Tool.

#### Key Points

- The new genome editing tool is significantly smaller than conventional tools.
- This tool could enhance crop traits, reduce susceptibility to pests, and improve resilience against extreme weather.
- This compact size allows it to be easily delivered into plant cells.
- The tool leverages CRISPR-Cas9 technology, which acts like molecular scissors, cutting the DNA at specific locations to introduce beneficial traits.

Genome editing is a technique used to modify a cell's DNA precisely and efficiently.

CRISPR-Cas9 is a revolutionary genome editing technology that allows precise modification of DNA sequences within cells.

## Mithun (Bos frontalis)

- Assam has recorded the mithun (Bos frontalis) for the first time, generations after the semi-wild gaur-like animal began to be reared by tribals in the state's hill district of Dima Hasao.
- Mithun is the state animal of Arunachal Pradesh and Nagaland and found also in the hills of Mizoram and Manipur. It is primarily reared for its meat.



As per the 20th livestock census held in 2019, Mithun are found in four states, viz., Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, and Nagaland.

Bihar

## Miscellaneous

- India became the top buyer of Russian Oil, surpassing China. India imported a record 2.07 million barrels per day (bpd) of Russian oil in July, surpassing China's 1.76 million bpd.
- IndiGo is evaluating introducing the gender-neutral option of honorific 'Mx' for internal candidates as part of larger efforts to boost inclusivity.
- Goldman Sachs Group Inc. has lowered India's growth forecast by 20 basis points each for this year and the next, citing a contraction in central government expenditure. The bank now expects the nation's economy to expand at 6.7% in calendar 2024, and 6.4% in 2025. The current year's downgrade is due to contraction in government expenditure during the April-June quarter.
