Janjatiya Gaurav Divas celebration

Why in the news?

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Jamui, Bihar, on Janjatiya Gaurav Divas to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary year of tribal leader Birsa Munda.

Key Development Projects:

- Grih Pravesh Ceremony: inauguration of 11,000 houses under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN).
- Mobile Medical Units (MMUs): Inauguration of 23 MMUs under PM-JANMAN and 30 additional MMUs under Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA)
- * Tribal Entrepreneurship & Education:
 Inauguration of 300 Van Dhan Vikas
 Kendras (VDVKs), 10 Eklavya Model
 Residential Schools for tribal students
 (worth Rs 450 crore) and the
 foundation stone for 25 more Eklavya
 Model Residential Schools (worth Rs
 1,110 crore).

- Cultural Preservation: Inauguration of two Tribal Freedom Fighters' Museums in Chhindwara and Jabalpur, MP and two Tribal Research Institutes in Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir, and Gangtok, Sikkim.
- Infrastructure Development: Foundation stone for 500 km of new roads and 100 Multi-Purpose Centres (MPCs) under PM-JANMAN.


Housing and Infrastructure:

- 11,000 homes under PM-JANMAN and over 1.16 lakh under DAJGUA.
- 66 hostels under PM-JANMAN and
 304 under DAJGUA.
- Upgraded tribal schools, sickle cell anaemia centres, and Anganwadi centres.

Ceremonial Events

- unveil a commemorative coin and postal stamp in honour of Birsa Munda
- Grih Pravesh for new homes built for tribal families.

- Every year on November 15th, Janjatiya Gaurav Divas is celebrated to honor the contributions of these communities, especially in India's freedom struggle.
- Since 2021, Janjatiya Gaurav Divas has been celebrated.

About Birsa Munda

- Birsa Munda, a tribal freedom fighter and folk hero from the Munda tribe in the Chhotanagpur Plateau, led the Munda Rebellion (Ulgulan) against British colonial rule in the late 19th century.
- He played a pivotal role in the independence movement in the Bihar-Jharkhand region and passed away on June 9, 1900, at the age of 25.

Defence And Security

Flight Tests of Guided Pinaka Weapon System completed

Why in the news?

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully completed the Flight Tests of Guided Pinaka Weapon System as part of Provisional Staff Qualitative Requirements (PSQR) Validation Trials.

- Tests conducted in three phases at different field firing ranges using 12 rockets from each production agency on upgraded Pinaka launchers.
- During these tests, the PSQR parameters viz., ranging, accuracy, consistency and rate of fire for multiple target engagement in a salvo mode have been assessed by extensive testing of rockets.
- The system is entirely indigenous, developed by DRDO's Armament Research and Development Establishment, along with other DRDO labs and private-sector production partners.
- Ammunition produced by Munitions
 India Limited and Economic
 Explosives Limited; launchers and
 command systems developed by
 Tata Advanced Systems Limited and
 Larsen & Toubro.

Guru Nanak Jayanti 2024

Why in the news?

Guru Nanak Jayanti, also called **Guru Nanak Prakash Utsav**, commemorates

the birthday of Guru Nanak, the founder

of Sikhism and one of the most revered

Sikh Gurus.

November 15,2024 which will be Guru Nanak Dev Ji's 555th birth anniversary.

About Guru Nanak

Guru Nanak (1469–1539), the founder of Sikhism and the first Sikh Guru, was born in Rai Bhoi di Talvandi (now Nankana Sahib, Pakistan).

He spread the message of 'Ek Omkar' (God is one and omnipresent) and emphasized connecting with God through a clean conscience.

Key contributions include:

- Establishing the three pillars of Sikhism: Naam Japna (meditation), Kirat Karni (honest living), and Vand Chakna (sharing with others).
- Rejecting the caste system, ritualism,
 and discrimination, promoting
 equality for all.
- Introducing Sangat, a community for collective worship.
- A poet, mystic, and philosopher, Guru Nanak's teachings are compiled in the Guru Granth Sahib, Sikhism's central holy scripture.







Jharkhand Foundation Day 2024

Why in the news?


Jharkhand Foundation Day is celebrated every year on **November 15**.

- Jharkhand Foundation Day commemorates the founding of India's 28th state. The state was a part of Bihar before the Bihar Reorganisation Act of 2000.
- The state is currently made up of the forests of Santhal Pargana and Chhotanagpur Plateau.

About Jharkhand

- State in eastern India, created on 15 November 2000, from what was previously the southern half of Bihar.
- The State shares its border with the States of Bihar to the north, Uttar Pradesh to the northwest, Chhattisgarh to the west, Odisha to the south and West Bengal to the east.
- It has an area of 79,714 km² (30,778 sq mi). It is the 15th largest State by area, and the 14th largest by population.
- Hindi is the official language of the State. The city of Ranchi is its capital and Dumka its sub capital.

The State is known for its waterfalls, hills and holy places: Baidyanath Dham, Parasnath and Rajrappa are major religious sites.
