Swachh Sujal Gaon

Mahakumbh 2025 to showcase Bundelkhand's transformation of bringing Tap Water to every Household through Jal Jeevan Mission.

Key Points

In the Mahakumbh 2025 the devotees from across the globe will witness



the remarkable transformation of Uttar Pradesh's villages through the concept of 'Swachh Sujal Gaon' (Clean and Water-Secure Villages).

- The theme of the initiative is 'Solution to Drinking Water: New Identity of My Village', which highlights how Bundelkhand, once synonymous with water scarcity, now stands as a symbol of success in resolving the drinking water crisis.
- The exhibition will be set across 40,000 square feet, it will represent a vivid picture of a prosperous Uttar Pradesh, highlighting initiatives such as PM Awas, CM Awas, gram panchayat development, and village solar energy adoption.
- The exhibit will provide multilingual accessibility, with information in Hindi, English, Bengali, Telugu, and Marathi, ensuring inclusivity for a diverse audience.

Good Governance Week 2024

The UP government has secured the top position in the nation during the Good Governance Week 2024.

Key Points

- Resolution of Grievances: The UP government secured the top position in the nation during the Good Governance Week 2024 by resolving over 6,08,617 public grievances.
 - ➤ This remarkable achievement reflects the administrative efficiency and unwavering commitment of the Yogi government towards public service.
 - Maharashtra and Rajasthan claimed the second and third spots with 2,33,892 and 2,13,415 grievance resolutions, respectively.
- Workshop conducted: Uttar Pradesh also led the country in organising workshops at block and headquarters levels, with Madhya Pradesh following in second place.
 - Uttar Pradesh stood out by organising the highest number of workshops (16,997) securing the top position in the country. Madhya Pradesh came second with 13,128 workshops, while Rajasthan took third place with 5,810 workshops.
 - These workshops were organised nationwide at block, tehsil, district and headquarters levels to address public grievances, raise awareness, and promote transparency in administrative work

About Naxalism

- Naxalism refers to a Maoist-inspired insurgency that seeks to overthrow the Indian state through armed rebellion.
- The movement emerged from a peasant uprising in 1967 against local landlords who were exploiting agricultural workers.
- This revolt led to the formation of various left-wing extremist groups, collectively known as Naxalites.
- The movement has spread across several states in India, particularly in

areas known as the "Red Corridor," which includes parts of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Bihar, and WestV Bengal.



Respirer Living Sciences Report

Indian Cities Reduce PM2.5 Pollution By 27% In Six Years

Key Points

According to the report by climate tech firm Respirer Living Sciences, Indian cities achieved an average 27 per cent reduction in PM2.5 pollution levels from 2019 to 2024, with those under NCAP alone recording a 24 per cent decline.



- Top Performers: According to the report Varanasi and Moradabad reduced PM2.5 levels by 76 per cent and 58 per cent, respectively.
 - ➤ Other top performers include Kalaburagi (57.2 per cent), Meerut (57.1 per cent), Katni (56.3 per cent), Agra (54.1 per cent), Baghpat (53.3 per cent), Kanpur (51.2 per cent) and Jodhpur (50.5 per cent).
- Polluted cities: In 2024, Delhi recorded PM2.5 levels of 107 microgrammes per cubic metre while Byrnihat in Assam reported 127.3 microgrammes per cubic metre.
 - Other highly polluted cities include Gurugram (96.7 microgrammes per cubic metre), Faridabad (87.1 microgrammes per cubic metre), Sri Ganganagar (85.5 microgrammes per cubic metre), and Greater Noida (83.9 microgrammes per cubic metre).

Green Hydrogen Hub

On 8th January 2024, the Prime Minister of India laid the foundation stone for the NTPC Green Energy Limited (NGEL) Green Hydrogen Hub project.

Key Points

- It is the first Green Hydrogen Hub under the National Green Hydrogen Mission.
- Developers: The project, jointly developed by NGEL and the New & Renewable Energy Development Corporation of Andhra Pradesh (NREDCAP).
- Location: It will be located in Pudimadaka, Anakapalle district, Andhra Pradesh
- It will be developed with an investment of approximately Rs1.85 lakh crore.

Production: It will include the development of 20 GW of renewable energy projects and the production of 1,500 tonnes per day (TPD) of green hydrogen, along with 7,500 TPD of green hydrogen derivatives such as green methanol, green urea, and sustainable aviation fuel. These products are primarily aimed at export markets.

Key Points

- Organizer: The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) (DEPwD), under Union Ministry of Social Justice **Empowerment** (M/o SJ&E),is organizing the 23rd Divya Kala Mela through its apex Corporation, National Divyangjan Finance and Development Corporation (NDFDC), at Akota Stadium, Vadodara, Gujarat.
- ❖ Time span: From 9th 19th January 2024
- The 11-day event will be showcasing a diverse range of products and craftsmanship of Divyang entrepreneurs/artisans from across the country.
- The Mela is a unique initiative towards the economic empowerment of PwD/Divyangjan.
- It presents a big platform for marketing and showcasing the products and skills of Divyangjan (PwD).

21st Third Eye Asian Film Festival

Key Points

The opening film of the festival was the acclaimed Chinese drama The Black



Dog, which won the Best Film award at the Cannes Film Festival.

- ❖ A total of 61 films have been selected for the festival, which will run from 10th-16th January.
- The Asian Spectrum section will feature films from countries including China, Malaysia, Bangladesh, Kazakhstan, Tunisia, and Bhutan, showcasing a wide variety of storytelling styles. South Korea is the Country in Focus.
- Renowned lyricist and screenwriter Javed Akhtar will be honoured with the Asian Cinema Culture Award.
- Journalist Rafique Baghdadi will receive the Satyajit Ray Memorial Award.

Short News-Uttar Pradesh

Northern hotel', a 150-year-old heritage building in Prayagraj. The building, located in the Prayagraj Municipal Corporation premises was built around 1865. The historic building was once used for meetings of intellectuals involved in the country's freedom struggle. In the 1930s, the British government converted this building into an administrative office. This building was constructed 150 years ago using eco-friendly materials such as jaggery, pulses, fenugreek, lime, surkhi, sand and bell giri and now its renovation using the same materials.

- * The former IPS officer and the secretary of Patna's Mahavir Mandir Trust. Acharya Kishore Kunal died recently.
