Schedule of 2<sup>nd</sup> round and other subsequent rounds (if any) of online counselling will be intimated online through the Council Website. Any subsequent Notification/Notice/Amendments/Corrigendum issued by the Government of Punjab/ PNRC/ INC will be followed in letter and spirit. For any updates visit the Council website regularly.

## 2. INTRODUCTION

The Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC) is a regulatory body responsible for the admission and examination of ANM and GNM Courses and registration of nurses and midwives in the state of Punjab (India). PNRC ensures that nursing professionals meet the necessary standards of education, training and practice to provide safe and effective healthcare services in the state of Punjab.

PNRC invites applications for admission to ANM and GNM diploma courses in its affiliated nursing institutes for Session 2024-25 through Centralized Counselling as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council and Government of Punjab. Centralized Online Counselling shall be conducted by Punjab Nurses Registration Council within specified timelines for admission and it shall be ensured that the final counselling by the Council shall be completed by date fixed by INC (subject to approval from Govt. of Punjab)

For admission Session 2024-2025, the list of affiliated Government/Private institutes along with course and category-wise seat distribution will be published on PNRC website at the time of Choice filling. Candidates are advised to plan their admission in affiliated institutions only to avoid any inconvenience. Selection of the candidates to any institution will be made purely on merit basis and in a transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification no. 5/10/2017-5HB3/2115 dated 03/10/23.

# 3. DEFINITIONS

- i. "ANM" means Auxiliary Nurse and Midwifery.
- ii. "Council or PNRC" means Punjab Nurses Registration Council.
- iii. "Eligible Candidate" means a candidate who fulfills the requirements of eligibility as prescribed in the Prospectus/ Government Notification as amended from time to time and other notifications issued for this purpose from time to time and the criteria of PNRC.
- iv. "GNM" means General Nursing and Midwifery.
- v. "Government Notification" means Notification no.5/10/2017-5HB3/2115 dated 03/10/23 as amended from time to time and other notifications issued for this purpose from time to time by the Department of Medical Education and Research.
- vi. "INC" means Indian Nursing Council.
- vii. "PWD" means Persons with Disability.

# 4. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants are required to read carefully following INSTRUCTIONS before proceeding to the application process.

- a) Candidates can apply for admission in ANM and GNM Courses for session 2024-2025 through online mode only.
- b) The admission of GNM and ANM courses of all Government and Private Nursing institutions shall be made through Centralized Online Counselling to be conducted by PNRC. The classes would commence from 1st October 2024.
- c) Prospectus can be downloaded from the PNRC website <a href="www.pnrconline.in">www.pnrconline.in</a>
- d) Online submission of the application form be made on PNRC admission portal admission.pnrconline.in
- e) Candidate must follow the instructions strictly as given in the prospectus and on PNRC website.
   Candidate not complying with the instructions shall be disqualified.
- f) If at any stage, it is found that the candidate has supplied any false information in the admission form, then her/his candidature for the course shall be cancelled.
- g) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve/minority category shall be transferred to the General Category in second counselling, as per Instructions/ Policy of State Govt.
- h) The State Government reserves the right to amend any clause and procedure for admission without any prior notice.

#### 5. PROCEDURE OF CENTRALIZED COUNSELLING

Following procedure will be adopted for the centralized counselling to be conducted by PNRC.

- a) PNRC will publish prospectus on its website for Admission in ANM/GNM courses through Centralized Online Counselling.
- b) Candidates seeking admission in ANM/ GNM courses shall submit online applications for the counselling available on the PNRC website within the given timelines. Candidates have to submit full details including personal, academic and reservation (if applicable) details along with the required documents on the portal.
- c) Counselling fee shall be Rs 1000/- + 18% GST to be deposited online by the candidate at the time of online application only. For SC/ST category counselling fee shall be 50% of the total counselling fee. Online Application form completed in all respects shall be submitted within stipulated time. No Application form after the last date shall be entertained in any case.
- d) Candidates will have to provide their choices on the portal within specified timelines. At least one choice of institute has to be filled to be eligible for further admission process.
- e) After the cut-off date, the Merit List will be prepared and published on the PNRC website as per the given schedule.
- f) Candidates shall be allotted an institution of their choice in order of preference, as per the Merit List.
- g) PNRC will publish allotment results on its website/portal.
- h) The allotted candidates shall report to their allotted institution along with required documents (Photocopy and Original) within specified timelines as per the prospectus.
- i) The candidates failing to report within the timeline will not be considered for the allotted seat after the last date of reporting and the seat shall be considered as vacant for the next round of counselling, if any.
- j) The institution shall update the reporting of allotted students on the last date through the portal.
- k) In case of vacant seats, the second round of counselling and mop-up round can be conducted to fill the remaining seats, which will be decided by PNRC. The Details will be updated online.
- I) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve category shall be merged with the general category seats in the second counselling, as per the instructions of State of Punjab
- m) In case student shifts from one institution to another, Tuition Fee shall be refunded to student by the institute within 7 days.
- n) Initial verification of documents shall be done at institute level at the time of reporting after allotment of seat.
- o) If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round of counseling and then participates in the second round by filling in new choices, the seat allotted in the first round will be automatically canceled, if seat is allotted in second round. The seat from the first round will then be considered vacant and available for other candidates for allotment.

Detailed steps to fill application form on PNRC Admission Portal is given in Annexure A. Students are advised to review the steps carefully beforehand.

**5.1 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:** Following documents will be required to upload on portal for Online Admission and Counselling Application. Applicants are advised to scan the original documents and to maintain the original color, visibility and clarity of content of the document.

#### **5.2 MERIT LIST PREPARATION**

#### 5.2.1 FOR GNM COURSE-

- a) The Merit List shall be prepared on the basis of average marks obtained in three core subjects of 12<sup>th</sup> Class or equivalent qualification (subject to equivalency certificate by Punjab School Education Board). The rest of the qualifying criteria will remain the same.
- b) Preference shall be given to Science (Medical) students in the merit list. Applicants of the Science medical stream shall be given priority in the merit list over applicants of other stream.
- c) EQUAL MARKS IN QUALIFYING CRITERIA: The inter se merit of candidates for tie-breaking in qualifying criteria shall be determined in the following manner:
  - i. Candidates obtaining higher marks in Biology (Botany and Zoology) in the qualifying exam for Science medical stream and 10<sup>th</sup> aggregate marks for other streams.
  - ii. Candidates obtaining higher marks in Chemistry in the qualifying exam (for science stream medical only).
  - iii. Candidates older in age (for all streams).

## 5.2.2 FOR ANM COURSE-

- a) The Merit List shall be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in 12th Class or equivalent (subject to equivalency certificate by Punjab School Education Board). The rest of the Qualifying criteria will remain the same.
- b) EQUAL MARKS IN QUALIFYING CRITERIA: The inter se merit of candidates for tie-breaking in qualifying criteria shall be determined in the following manner:
  - i. Candidates obtaining higher marks in 10<sup>th</sup> aggregate marks.
  - ii. Candidates older in age (for all streams).

# 7. RESERVATION POLICY FOR GNM and ANM COURSES

As per the Punjab Government Notification no.5/10/2017-5HB3/2115 dated 03/10/23, following reservation policy shall be applicable for Government and Private nursing institutes. The reservation policy is based on 100 points roster. The applicant has to attach the relevant documentary proof to avail the benefit of reservation. Any application seeking reservation but not supported with documentary proof shall attract cancellation of the application/allotted seat (if any).

Category Code of various reservation categories is mentioned in Annexure B.

# 7.1 RESERVATION IN GOVERNMENT INSTITUTES:

#### 7.3 GENERAL CONDITIONS OF RESERVATION:

- a) Students claiming benefits of reservation under SC/BC category shall be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per latest instructions of Government of Punjab. Further, a valid Backward Class Certificate must be produced as per the latest instructions of Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab in which the annual income of the family is clearly mentioned.
- b) Scheduled Caste/Backward Classes category candidates shall be eligible to apply for Post-Matric Scholarship and reimbursement of fee, if they fulfil the terms and conditions laid down by Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab.
- c) The reservation of Differently abled person (PWD) shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act,2016.
- d) Seats Remaining vacant under any of the reserve/ minority category shall be transferred to the General Category and vice versa.
- e) The State Government/PNRC reserves the right to amend any clause and procedure for admission.
- f) In case of any doubt, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education and Research, Government of Punjab may issue clarification which will have force of the policy.

g) For any dispute arising out of this Prospectus or of the admission process under the Notification/corrigendum, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education and Research, Government of Punjab shall be competent to resolve, whose decision shall be final.

## 7.4 HORIZONTAL RESERVATION FOR ANM/MPHW(F) COURSES ONLY:

Horizontal Reservation for the following categories of workers with specified qualifications and experience will be given in each category in both Govt. and Private Nursing Institutions in ANM Course.

i.	Trained Dai and ASHA Workers	10%
ii.	Anganwari workers	
iii.	Students who have done last four years of schooling from rural schools in the Punjab State	

- The Preference will be as above specified order i.e. (i), (ii) and (iii)
- The admission fee for the above categories (i) to (iii) will be 50 % of the total admission fee.

The eligibility criteria for such reservations are as follows

#### 7.4.1 FOR TRAINED DAIS:

- a) The candidates apply under their own categories and if adequate candidates are not available the seats shall automatically go to other candidates.
- b) The candidate should fulfil all the basic educational qualifications and other criteria required for admission to the (Multipurpose Health Worker(Female) Training Course/Auxiliary Nurse and Midwifery (ANM) as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council.
- c) The candidate should have worked as trained Dais for a minimum of 5 years in the State of Punjab on regular basis and should still be continuing to work as trained dai and candidates with more number of years in service will be given preference with one mark per year in services.
- d) Annual Appraisal reports for the last 5 years should be 'very good' or above and the same is considered as, an essential criteria.
- e) At the time of admission, she must furnish a bond of Rs.1 Lakh to serve the Punjab State for atleast 5 years, if offered a job in Punjab.

# 7.4.2 FOR ASHA WORKERS:

 a) The candidates will apply under their own categories and if adequate candidates are not available the seats shall automatically go to other candidates.

- b) The candidates should fulfil all the basic educational qualification and other criteria required for admission to the (Multipurpose Health Worker (Female) Training course /Auxiliary Nurse and Midwifery (ANM) as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council.
- c) The candidate should have worked as ASHA Worker for a minimum of 5 years in the State of Punjab on regular basis and should still be continuing to work as ASHA worker and candidates with more number of years working as ASHA worker will be given preference with one mark per year working as ASHA worker.
- d) Her Annual Appraisal reports for the last 5 years should be 'very good' or above and the same is considered as, an essential criteria.
- e) She should have earned an incentive of Rs. 24,000/- per annum in the last five years.
- f) At the time of admission, she must furnish a bond of Rs. One lakh to serve the Punjab State for at least 15 years, if offered a job in Punjab.

#### 7.4.3 FOR ANGANWARI WORKERS:

- a) The candidates will apply under their own categories and if adequate candidates are not available the seats shall automatically go to other candidates.
- b) The candidate should fulfil all the basic educational qualifications and other criteria required for admission to the (Multipurpose Health Worker (female) Training course/Auxiliary Nurse and Midwifery (ANM), as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council.
- c) The candidate should have worked as Anganwari Worker for a minimum of 5 years in the State of Punjab on regular basis and should still be continuing to work as Anganwari Worker and candidates with more number of years in service will be given preference with one mark per year in service.
- d) Her Annual Appraisal reports for the last 5 years should be 'very good' or above and the same is considered as, an essential criteria.
- e) At the time of admission, she must furnish a bond of Rs. 5 lakh to serve the Punjab State for at least 15 years if offered a job in Punjab.

# 8. COURSES OFFERED BY PNRC

# 8.1 GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY COURSE(GNM): 3 YEAR DIPLOMA COURSE

- a) SYLLABUS Syllabus will be in accordance with the instructions issued by Indian Nursing Council from time to time.
- b) DURATION OF THE COURSE The Duration of the course shall be three years.
- c) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION -
  - A. Fresh Candidates (On the basis of 12th from recognized board):
    - Age: Minimum age for admission will be 17 years and the age shall be determined as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024.

#### ii) Minimum Qualifications:

- ➤ 10 +2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40 % at the qualifying examination from any recognized Board. Candidates are also eligible from state Open School recognized by state Government and National Institute of Open School (NISO) recognized by Central Government. It has to be ensured that candidate has pass marks in English.
- ➤ 10 +2 with English having 40 % marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council
- 10+2 with English having 40 % marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE Board/State/Centre
- > Registered ANM with a pass mark.
- > For SC/ST candidates: 5% of total marks is relaxed for SC/ST candidates.
- For foreign nationals

The entry qualification equivalence i.e., 12<sup>th</sup> standard will be obtained by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. The concerned institution and Punjab Nurses Registration Council will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed as above.

- **iii) Residence Status**: Preference will be given to the candidates who are residents of Punjab. Resident of Punjab Means:-
  - > The candidate should have born in the State of Punjab or
  - ➤ The candidate who has studied 10+1 and 10+2 in Punjab or
  - > The candidate must be a permanent resident of the State of Punjab

Note:-Permanent resident means:-

- Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding to the qualifying examination for the admission. Or
- Children/Wards of:-
  - a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of services. Or
  - The employees of Govt. of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years.
     Or
  - c) The employees of State Govt. institutions/undertakings who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. Or
  - d) The employees having at least 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Govt. has 20 % or more shares. Or

- e) The Residents who are residing Outside Punjab on account of their service either with the GOI or with the employees of the Govt .of Punjab in the matter of issue of "Residence Certificate" provided the permanent address of such employees fall in the recognized Punjab i.e. on or after 1.11.66, as per their service books. Or
- f) The employees born on the establishment of Punjab and the Haryana High Court discharging duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Punjab having atleast three years of service and have not availed this facility from their parent State and State of Haryana and U.T, Chandigarh. Or
- Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab. Or
- Children/ wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or resided in Punjab for a period of at least 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job.

In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission under exempted category:-

- a) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
- b) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI Category.
- c) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- d) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out to the three years preceding year passing 10 +2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII for equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However, those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for those three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.
- iv) Medical: Candidate should be medically fit and must upload the Medical Certificate issued by Registered doctor (MBBS/MD/MS Practitioner doctor) at the time of applying for counselling.
- v) **Preference:** Preference shall be given to those who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent with science subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology.

vi) All candidates who are Indian Nationals shall have to produce the copy of Aadhar Card whose number shall be entered in the records of PNRC.

## B. Promotee (On basis of ANM):

- i) Age:- For ANM pass candidates, there is no age bar.
- ii) Minimum Qualifications:-
  - a) Candidates should be a Registered ANM with the Punjab Nurses Registration Council.
  - b) The candidate should have passed 12 years of schooling (10+2) or its equivalent (Subject to equivalency certificate by Punjab School Education Board) from a recognized Board or Recognized Open School of State Govt./Central Govt.
- iii) Medical: The candidate should be medically fit and must upload the Medical Certificate issued by Registered doctor (MBBS/MD/MS Practitioner doctor) at the time of applying for counselling.

# 8.2 AUXILIARY NURSE AND MIDWIFERY COURSE(ANM): 2 YEAR DIPLOMA COURSE

- a) SYLLABUS: The syllabus will be in accordance with the instructions issued by the Indian Nursing Council from time to time.
- **b) DURATION OF THE COURSE**: Duration of the Course shall be two years (18 months + 6 months internship)
- c) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:
  - i) Age: Minimum age for admission shall be 17 years (the age shall be determined as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of that year)
  - ii) Minimum Qualifications: A candidate must have passed 10 +2 with English from a recognized Board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government.

### For Foreign nationals

The entry qualification equivalency i.e. 12th standard will be obtained by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. The concerned Institution and Punjab Nurses Registration Council will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed as above.

- iii) Residence Status: Preference will be given to the candidates who are residents of Punjab
  - The candidate should have born in the State of Punjab Or
  - ➤ The candidate who have studied 10+1 and 10 +2 in Punjab Or
  - The candidate must be permanent resident of the State of Punjab

Note:-Permanent resident means:-

Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding the qualifying examination for the admission. Or

#### > Children wards of:-

- a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of service. Or
- The employees of Govt. of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years.
   Or
- c) The employees of State Govt. institutions/undertakings who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. Or
- d) The employees having at least 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Govt. has 20 % or more shares. Or
- e) The Residents who are residing Outside Punjab on account of their service either with the Gol or with the employees of the Govt. of Punjab in the matter of issue of "Residence Certificate" provided the permanent address of such employees falls in the recognized Punjab i.e. on or after 1.11.66, as per their service books. Or
- f) The employees born on the establishment of Punjab and the Haryana High Court discharging duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Punjab having at least three years of service and have not availed this facility from their parent State and State of Haryana and U.T, Chandigarh. Or
- > Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab. Or
- Children/ wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or resided in Punjab for a period of at least 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job.

In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission under exempted category:-

- a) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
- b) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI Category.
- c) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- d) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out to the three years preceding year passing 10 +2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to

which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII for equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However, those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for those three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.

- **iv) Medical**: The candidate should be medically fit and must upload the Medical Certificate issued by Registered doctor (MBBS/MD/MS Practitioner doctor) at the time of applying for counselling.
- v) All candidates who are Indian Nationals shall have to produce the copy of Aadhar card whose number shall be entered in the records of PNRC.
