## Kakori Train Incident- Centenary Festival

Commemorating the 100th anniversary of the Kakori train incident on August 9, 2024, the U.P government has announced the celebration of the Kakori train incident centenary festival.

## Key Points

- Span: The Kakori train incident centenary festival will be celebrated from August 9, 2024, till August 9, 2025.
- Objective: The main objective of the festival is to introduce school children, youth, and the new generation to sacrifices of national heroes and their life principles.



## About Kakori Train Incident

- The Kakori train incident was a significant event in the history of the Indian freedom struggle.
- To keep up their war against British rule, the revolutionaries required money, so they looted the train. The train robbery that took place on August 9, 1925, at Kakori town in present-day Uttar Pradesh.
- As a consequence, freedom fighters Ram Prasad Bismil, Rajendra Nath Lahiri, Roshan Singh, and Ashfaq Ullah Khan were sentenced to death, while other revolutionaries received imprisonment sentences in the Cellular Jail (Kaala Pani).
  - The forest department of UP state created Shaheed Smriti Vatika in every district to commemorate 100 years of the Kakori train.
