IAF C-295 Full Motion Simulator Facility

On 11th November 2024, the Indian Air Force inaugurated a Full Motion Simulator (FMS) facility at Air Force Station Agra.

Key Points

- It is to train and support its pilots on the newly inducted medium tactical transport platform Airbus C-295.
- The facility was inaugurated by OC-in-C Central Air Command Air Marshal Ashutosh Dixit.
- ** The state of the art simulator enables the pilots to train in near realistic simulating environment by various missions like tactical airlift, para-dropping, para-trooping, medical evacuation. disaster relief and also enables simulation of several critical situations that can be encountered in actual operations, ensuring that our pilots are battle ready.
- It will allow pilots to hone their skills in handling high risk emergencies that require time critical decisions, thereby enhancing the overall flight safety of military operations.
- This cutting-edge facility will substantially enhance the operational capability of the C-295 fleet.

Benefits

- A significant proportion of the pilot's training can be undertaken in the simulator thereby saving precious flying hours on the aircraft.
- The induction of C-295 aircraft into IAF will give a fillip to the aerospace ecosystem of the country, marking the beginning of "Atmanirbhar Bharat" in private sector production of transport aircraft in India.

Maulana Abul Kalam Azad

November 11 is observed as National Education Day, to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad.

About Maulana Abul Kalam Azad


- He was a journalist, freedom fighter, and senior Congress leader.
- Early life: He was born Abul Kalam Ghulam Muhiyuddin on November 11th 1888 in Mecca, Saudi Arabia. His father, Maulana Khairuddin, was a renowned Islamic scholar.
 - Azad was inspired by the modernist writings of Indian philosopher and educationist Sir Syed Ahmed Khan.
- Role in Independence movement: Azad had a brief participation in the Khilafat Movement, during which he held the post of president of the All-India Khilafat Committee.
 - Inspired by Mahatma Gandhi, he actively participated in the Dandi March and the Quit India Movement. He was imprisoned several times between 1920 and 1945.
 - He became the president of the Indian National Congress on two occasions

in 1923 and 1940.

- As communal polarisation worsened in the decade before independence and India headed towards Partition, Azad remained committed to Hindu Muslim unity, to the extent that Muhammad Ali Jinnah termed him "a Muslim showboy" of the Congress.
- First Education Minister: He was India's (independent) first education minister.



During Azad's tenure as the education minister of India, the country got statutory bodies like the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kharagpur. He also played a key role in the establishment of Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI).



- Death: Azad died on February 22, 1958.
- ❖ National Education Day: The government of India in 2008 declared November 11 as National Education Day and the then President, Pratibha Patil, inaugurated the celebrations at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.
- Awards: Maulana Azad was posthumously awarded Bharat Ratna, the highest civilian award in the country, in 1992.

Acharya Kripalani

On 11th November, the nation paid tribute to Acharya Kripalani on his birth anniversary.

Key Points

- Acharya Kripalani was born on November
 11, 1888, in Hyderabad, Sindh.
- He played a key role in India's struggle for Independence.

- He was the President of the Indian National Congress at the time of India's Independence and served in various critical roles, including in the Interim Government of India (1946-1947) and the Constituent Assembly of India.
- In 2004, My Times published his autobiography posthumously.

Antariksha Abhyas 2024

On 11th November 2024, Antariksha Abhyas 2024 begins in New Delhi.

Key Points

- It is a first of its kind exercise being conducted and is expected to help secure national strategic objectives in space and integrate India's space capability in military operations.
- Host: It is conducted by the Defence Space Agency of Headquarters Integrated Defence Staff.
- Aim: The Space Exercise aims to provide enhanced understanding of space based assets and services and to gain understanding of operational dependency on space segments between stakeholders.



Participation: It has participants from the Defence Space Agency and its allied units along with personnel from the Army, Navy and the Air Force.



Specialist branches under Headquarters Integrated Defence Staff viz Defence Cyber Agency, Defence Intelligence Agency and Strategic Forces Command would also be active participants in conduct of the exercise. Representatives from Indian Space Research Organisation the Defence Research Development Organisation also took part in it.
