## **Operation Dronagiri**

The Department of Science and Technology has launched Operation Dronagiri.

#### **Key Points**

- It is a pilot project under National Geospatial Policy 2022.
- It is to demonstrate the potential applications of geospatial technologies and innovations in improving the quality of life of citizens and ease of doing business.
- ❖ In the first phase, Operation Dronagiri will be implemented in the states of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Assam, Andhra Pradesh & Maharashtra, where pilot projects will be run and use cases will be demonstrated to showcase the potential applications of integration of geospatial data and technology in 3 sectors:- Agriculture, Livelihoods, Logistics and Transport.
- This will create the base for its Nationwide roll out.
- The activities under Operation Dranagiri will be overseen by IIT Tirupati Navavishkar I-Hub Foundation (IITTNiF). The Geospatial Innovation Accelerators (GIAs) at IIT Kanpur, IIT Bombay, IIM Calcutta and IIT Ropar will act as the operational arms of Operation Dronagiri.

#### **AYUSH University**

The construction of AYUSH University in Gorakhpur is set to be completed by the end of November month and will become operational by the end of the year.

#### **Key Points**

- It is Uttar Pradesh's first AYUSH University.
- This university, named after the renowned Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath, will offer a variety of traditional courses covering all medical systems related to AYUSH.
- In addition to these, the university will introduce innovative and unique courses tailored to meet contemporary demands.
- The foundation stone for this university, being built on a 52-acre area in Pipri, Bhathat, was laid on August 28, 2021, by the then President Ram Nath Kovind.

#### **Short News- Uttar Pradesh**

- The Yogi Adityanath government in Uttar Pradesh is taking significant steps to strengthen the law and order in the state, particularly through a more robust prosecution svstem. government is set to set up offices of joint director prosecution in 11 districts (Shravasti, Chandauli, Chitrakoot, Banda, Ghaziabad. Sant Kabir Nagar, Lalitpur, Sonbhadra. Maharajganj, Auraiya and Firozabad districts) of the state.
- ❖ Justice Giridhar Malaviya, grandson of Banaras Hindu University (BHU) founder Mahamana Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya, passed away on 18th November 2024. A former judge of the Allahabad high court, Giridhar Malaviya also served as the chancellor of BHU.

The Bone and Tissue Bank to come up at the King George's Medical University (KGMU), Lucknow will be functional in six months. KGMU will be the first super speciality hospital in Uttar Pradesh to have such a bank. At the bank, bones in various forms: chips, powder or the complete bone, tissues comprising ligaments and tendons are preserved at -80 degrees Celsius. Within 24 hrs of this preservation process, they become sterilised enough to be used on patients.

It is a nationwide campaign.



- The campaign will culminate on Human Rights Day, December 10, 2024, emphasizing the critical link between sanitation, human rights and dignity.
- The campaign reaffirms India's commitment to maintaining its Open Defecation Free (ODF) status while promoting behavioral change for cleaner, healthier communities.
- ❖ The tagline of the campaign is "शौचालय संवारं, जीवन निखारं".
- The campaign aims to improve sanitation infrastructure, foster behavior change, and strengthen community pride by enhancing the functionality and aesthetics of toilets across the country.

#### Narendra Modi SAKSHAM Yuva Abhiyan

- BJP Delhi Pradesh Executive Committee member Rajeev Pathak launched the Narendra Modi SAKSHAM Yuva Abhiyan in Kirari, Delhi on November 15, 2024.

World Toilet Day



- World Toilet Day was established in 2001 by the World Toilet Organization (WTO), founded by Jack Sim. In 2013, the United Nations formally recognized the day, driven by Singapore's collaboration with the WTO to draft the "Sanitation for All" resolution.
- The 2024 theme, 'Toilets A Place for Peace,' addresses the increasing risks to sanitation posed by conflicts, climate change, disasters, and neglect.

#### Chhattisgarh

Guru Ghasidas-Tamor Pingla Tiger Reserve in Chhattisgarh has been notified as the **56th Tiger Reserve of the country**.

#### Odisha

Twenty-four coastal villages in Odisha were recognised by the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission of UNESCO as 'Tsunami Ready'. The recognition was given during the 2nd Global Tsunami Symposium held in Indonesia. These villages are located in Balasore, Bhadrak, Kendrapada, Jagatsinghpur, Puri and Ganjam districts.

#### **Miscellaneous**

- Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), India's government-operated telecom provider, has launched its new Directto-Device satellite connectivity service.
  - This is India's first satellite-to-device communication service, developed in partnership with US-based communications technology company Viasat. It aimed at providing connectivity in remote areas, the new service is designed to help users stay connected even in isolated locations.
