Danapur Railway Division

Why in the news?

The historic Danapur division of the Indian Railways network completed 100 years on January 1, 2025.

Danapur (earlier Dinapore) division
 was established on January 1, 1925.

- Danapur division was put under the Kolkata-based Eastern Railway (ER) established in 1952.
- From 2002 onwards, it came under East Central Railway (ECR), carved out of ER, with headquarters at Hajipur in north Bihar.
- Its office is located in a majestic building erected in 1929 near the historic Danapur station at Khagaul town near Patna.
- The first divisional superintendent of Danapur was C Eyers, who took charge on January 1, 1925.
- The post was redesignated as divisional railway manager (DRM) from 1980s onwards, according to information displayed on the succession board.
- The current Danapur division spans the rail network from Jhajha to Kuchman.







Economy

India's Fiscal Deficit

Why in the news?

India's fiscal deficit for the first eight months of this fiscal year through November stood at 8.47 lakh crore rupees or **52.5 percent** of annual estimates.

- Total receipts stood at 18.94 lakh crore rupees, while overall expenditure from April to November was at 27.41 lakh crore rupees.
- These figures were 59.1 percent and 56.9 percent of this fiscal year's budget target.
- Tax revenue was 14.43 lakh crore rupees, and non-tax revenue was 4.27 lakh crore rupees.
 - The central government's fiscal deficit target is 4.9 percent of the gross domestic product for 2024-25, as announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in the Union Budget 2024-25 against 5.6 percent in 2023-24, which was lower than the revised estimates of 5.8 percent.

Environment And Geography

Groundwater Resource Assessment 2024

Why in the news?

Union Jal Shakti Minister **C R Patil** released the Dynamic Ground Water Resource Assessment Report for the year 2024.

The assessment was carried out jointly by the Central Ground Water Board and States and Union Territories.


* According to Report:

- The total annual groundwater recharge has been assessed as over 446 Billion Cubic Meters.
- The total annual groundwater recharge in the country has increased by 15 Billion Cubic Meters substantially and extraction has declined by three Billion Cubic Meters in 2024.
 - The annual groundwater extraction for all uses is over 245 Billion Cubic Meters. The report highlights that 100 percent of groundwater samples in the northeastern states are in an excellent category for irrigation.

- He is a 1993-batch IPS officer from the Uttar Pradesh cadre and is currently serving as Special Director General of the CRPF.

History:

- In 1999, all UN member states were encouraged to spend the first day of the year creating plans on maintaining peace.
- Due to the success of this day, the UN declared Global Family Day an annual event in 2001.
- Objective: It encourages people to build stronger relationships with their families.
- The theme for Global Family Day 2025 is 'One World, One Family: Building Bridges Across Generations.'
- Note: The International Day of Families is held on 15th May every year.
