## 'Jaago Grahak Jaago App'

The Department of Consumer Affairs launched 'Jago Grahak Jago App', 'Jagriti App' and 'Jagriti Dashboard' for public use on the occasion of National Consumer Day (24th December).

## **Key Points-**

- The 'Jago Grahak Jago App' provides essential e-commerce information about all URLs during a consumer's online activities, alerting them if a URL may be unsafe.
- The 'Jagriti App' allows users to report URLs where they suspect the presence of one or more dark patterns that have been declared illegal.
- The CCPA is also being strengthened with the 'Jagriti Dashboard', which is used to generate real-time reports on e-commerce URLs for the presence of the above dark patterns.

## Department of Science and Technology Year End Review 2024

- India's ranking in the Global Science and Technology Index has steadily increased
  - ➤ India has secured **39th position** among top innovative economies in the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2024.
  - As per the WIPO Report 2023, India is ranked 6th in terms of Intellectual Property (IP) filings in the world.
  - In the Network Readiness Index (NRI), India has moved up from 79th position (2019) to **49th position** (2024).

Research National Research Foundation launches EV Mission and Inclusion Research Grant.

#### National Quantum Mission

The Union Cabinet approved the National Quantum Mission (NQM) at a total cost of Rs 6003.65 crore for a period of eight years.

### National Supercomputing Mission (NSM)

➤ The mission is being jointly implemented by MeitY and DST and has set to create a computing capacity of 27 petaflops (PF) at 28 sites across the country by 2023.

## Climate Change Research

The Department implemented two National Missions on Climate Change

 (a) National Mission for Sustaining Himalayan Ecosystem (NMSHE) and
 (b) National Mission on Strategic Knowledge for Climate Change (NMSKCC).

## **❖** Women in Science and Engineering

- Two new programmes were launched, namely, Women International Grantin-Aid (WINGS) for research training in international laboratories and the Women Leadership Programme for early and mid-level women scientists.
- More than 340 women scientists were supported through major fellowship programs.
- Climate change initiatives were expanded with four new centres of excellence for flood and drought, and risk mapping.
- ❖ The Technology Development Board promoted innovation with assistance of ₹220.73 crore in seven major projects.

## 'Spadex' Mission

ISRO will launch India's 'SpaDex' mission from Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota on December 30.



#### **Key Points-**

- Under this mission, two small spacecraft will be launched simultaneously from the PSLV-C60 rocket.
- With the success of the mission, India will become the fourth country in the world capable of space 'docking' technology after America. Russia and China.
- Objective: The objective of this mission is to demonstrate the ability to 'dock' and 'undock' spacecraft in space.
  - The joining of one spacecraft with another is called docking and the separation of two connected spacecraft in space is called undocking.
- Significance: This technology is crucial for India's ambitious missions such as bringing back samples from the Moon, and building of Indian Space Centre (BAS).

## **No Detention Policy**

The Central Government has announced to removal of the 'no detention policy' of not failing school students.

## **Key Points-**

- Under this, if a student fails in class 5 and class 8, he/she will not be promoted to the next class.
- In 2009, a no-detention policy was implemented in schools, under which students up to class 8 were promoted even if they failed.
- The foundation for abolishing it was laid in 2019 by amending the Right to Education (RTE) Act. Now after five years, it has been amended.

# Dr. Ambedkar Samman Scholarship Scheme

- AAP (Aam Aadmi Party) national convenor and former Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal announced the 'Ambedkar Samman Scholarship Scheme'.
- Under this, the fees as well as travel and accommodation expenses of Dalit students of Delhi taking admission for higher education in top international universities will be borne.
- This scheme will also apply to the children of Dalit government employees.

#### **Uttar Pradesh - Short News**

- The governments of Manipur and Uttar

  Pradesh have signed a Memorandum of
  Understanding (MoU) to implement the

  'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat'

  programme, which aims to promote
  cultural exchange and mutual
  understanding between the two states.
- The event focuses on enhancing interaction and sharing best practices in areas such as language, culture, traditions, music, tourism, food, and sports.

#### Malaysia

- Malaysia has extended visa-free entry for Indian citizens until December 31, 2026.
- This is aimed at attracting more visitors, boosting economic progress and preparing for Visit Malaysia Year 2026.

#### **Miscellaneous**

Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) has been awarded eight national awards by the Public Relations Society of India (PRSI). These PRSI National Awards 2024 were presented at the 46th All India Public Relations Conference held in Raipur during December 20-22, 2024.



- Nissan Motor Company and Honda Motor Company have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for a merger. The aim of this merger is to get Nissan out of the current crisis and make it the world's third-largest auto company in terms of sales.
- \*\* The following 15 States/Union Territories have selected been showcase their tableaux on the dais for the Republic Day Parade 2025: Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chandigarh, Dadra Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Tripura, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.
- The theme of the tableau for Republic Day Celebration-2025 has been kept as 'Golden India: Heritage and Development'.

- A high-level committee headed by Defence Secretary, Rajesh Kumar Singh was constituted by the Government to consider the overall capability development of the Indian Air Force.
- ❖ Taking an important step to prevent Goods and Services Tax (GST) evasion, the GST Council approved a proposal to implement a 'track and trace' mechanism for certain goods suspected of tax evasion. Under this, a specific mark will be put on such goods or packets so that they can be traced in the supply chain.
