- Q1. Under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973:
 - (a) Only the statement of a person produced by the police or investigation agencies can be recorded.
 - (b) Statements of the person approaching the Magistrate independently can be recorded.
 - (c) The statement made need not be voluntary.
 - (d) The police officer is authorized to record the statement.
- Q2. As per Section 41A (1) of CrPC as inserted by the Code of Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Act, 2008 (5 of 2009) the Police Officer shall issue a notice directing the alleged accused though he has committed a cognizable offence, to appear before him or at such other place as specified in notice in all the cases where the arrest of a person is not required under the:
 - (a) provisions of sub-section (1)(a) of section 41
 - (b) provisions of sub-section (1)(b) of section 41
 - (c) provisions of sub-section (1)(c) of section 41
 - (d) provisions of sub-section (1) of section 41
- Q3. Under Section 376 of IPC 'Whoever, commits rape on a woman under sixteen years of age shall be punished with'
 - (a) Rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than twenty years, but which may extend to imprisonment for life
 - (b) Rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than ten years, but which may extend to imprisonment for life
 - (c) Rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than seven years, but which may extend to ten years.
 - (d) Rigorous imprisonment for a term which may extend to twenty years.

- Q4. Penetrative Sexual Assault comes under the category of Aggravated Penetrative Sexual Assault when:
