## Deepika Kumari wins silver medal at Archery World Cup Final 2024

India's star archer Deepika Kumari bagged a silver medal at the Archery World Cup Final 2024. This is her sixth World Cup medal. Kumari secured second place after China's Li Jiaman won 6-0 in the championship round.

#### Cyclonic storm 'Dana'

A low-pressure area in the Bay of Bengal is likely to develop into Cyclone Dana by October 23. It is expected to affect Odisha and West Bengal with heavy rains. Authorities in Odisha have put preparations in place.





# INDIAN NAVY - ROYAL NAVY OF OMAN MARITIME EXERCISE (NASEEM AL BAHR)

INS Trikand and Dornier Maritime Patrol Aircraft, participated in the Indo-Oman bilateral naval exercise Naseem-Al-Bahr with the Royal Navy of Oman Vessel Al Seeb off Goa.

The exercise was conducted in two phases: the harbour phase and the sea phase.

#### Mission Basundhara 3.0

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma launched Mission Basundhara 3.0 at Srimanta Sankardeva Kalakshetra in Guwahati. The mission aims to grant land rights to indigenous people. "The mission is part of the state government's efforts to simplify administrative processes and improve accessibility.

#### WHO certifies Egypt as malaria-free

Egypt is the third country to be awarded a malaria-free certification in the WHO Eastern Mediterranean Region following the United Arab Emirates and Morocco, and the first since 2010. Globally, a total of 44 countries and 1 territory have reached this milestone.
