#### BIMSTEC Business Summit

India hosted the first BIMSTEC Business Summit in New Delhi from August 6-8.

## Key Points:

- Organizers: It was organised by the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and Confederation of Indian Industries (CII).
- Aim: Foster greater regional collaboration through enhanced trade and investment relations among BIMSTEC member countries
- Focus Areas: Trade facilitation, regional connectivity, energy security, inclusive growth, and sustainable development.

#### BIMSTEC

- The Bay of Bengal Initiative for MultiSectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) is a regional organization aimed at fostering collaboration and integration among countries in the Bay of Bengal region.
- \* Established: June 6, 1997
- Members: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Nepal, India, Sri Lanka, Myanmar and Thailand.



Earlier in July 2024, National Security Advisor Ajit Doval led the Indian delegation at the 4th Annual Meeting of the Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) Security Chiefs held in Myanmar's capital, Naypyitaw.

# Tarang Shakti 2024

India's largest multilateral air exercise began on 6th August.

#### Key Points:



- The Indian Air Force is hosting its largest multilateral air exercise, 'Tarang Shakti,' in two phases starting August 6.
- Two Phases: The first phase is being held in Sulur, Tamil Nadu, from August 6 to 14.
  - Second phase will be held in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, from August 29 to September 14.



- Aim: The aim is to foster interoperability and share best practices and also to showcase the indigenous defence industry.
- Participants: Australia, Bangladesh, France, Germany, Greece, Spain, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, USA and Singapore. 18 Countries are attending as Observers.

## Paris Olympics 2024

- India's Vinesh Phogat, the wrestler has been disqualified from the 2024 Paris Olympics gold medal bout after failing to meet her 50 kg weight requirement.
  - Phogat, 29, was "found overweight by 100gm" which led to the disqualification. She was scheduled to take on United States' Sarah Hildebrandt in the final. Hildebrandt will now fight Cuba's Yusneylis Guzman, who lost to the Indian in the semi-final, for the gold medal. Yui Susaki of Japan and Oksana Livach of Ukraine will compete for bronze.
