'Hamara Bihar, Hamari Sadak' app

Why in the news?

The Chief Minister of Bihar inaugurated the 'Hamara Bihar, Hamari Sadak' app.

- This app will provide a list of 65 thousand km of rural roads with maintenance periods for all blocks of the state.
- Users can select the road of their block and report potholes or other problems with photos.
- This app has been developed to promote direct communication between citizens and the government. 'Hamara Bihar, Hamari Sadak' app will now be available on Google Play Store.

Science And Technology

Chinese Spacewalk Breaks a Record Why in the news?

Chinese astronauts Cai Xuzhe and Song Lingdong from the Shenzhou-19 mission completed a 9-hour spacewalk, surpassing the previous record of 8 hours and 56 minutes set by American astronauts in 2001.

The spacewalk was part of efforts to build and maintain China's Tiangong Space Station.

Aboard the mission were three astronauts:

- Cai Xuzhe and Song Lingdong performed the spacewalk.
- Wang Haoze, the third astronautengineer, remained inside the station to assist.
- The crew launched in late October 2024 and the spacewalk was conducted this week.
- The first spacewalk took place in 1965 when a Soviet astronaut spent 16 minutes outside his craft. Months later, an American astronaut completed one.
- The first spacewalk by a Chinese astronaut was in 2008, lasting 19 minutes.

World's Largest Museum

Why in the news?

The Ministry of Culture has announced a landmark partnership with France Museums Développement (FMD) to develop the Yuga Yugeen Bharat National Museum as a world-class cultural institution.

- This ambitious project is an integral part of the Central Vista Redevelop ment Project and is set to span approximately 1,55,000 square meters across the iconic North and South Blocks in New Delhi.
- First announced by the Prime Minister during the International Museum Expo in May 2023.

Features of the Museum

Adaptive Reuse:

- Preserves architectural heritage while transforming the North and South Blocks into vibrant cultural spaces.
- Inspired by France's "Grands Projets" initiative, which converted government buildings into iconic cultural landmarks.

Global Collaboration:

- Combines India's cultural legacy with France's museum management and design expertise.
- Aims to redefine the museum experience by celebrating diversity and fostering inclusivity.

Sahitya Akademi Awards 2024

Why in the news?

The 2024 Sahitya Akademi Awards have been announced, recognizing 21 writers and poets from various Indian languages.

- These awards honor exceptional works in categories like novels, poetry, short stories, essays, plays, and literary criticism.
- The littérateurs will be honoured with an engraved copper plaque, a shawl and ₹1 lakh in cash at a function to be held on March 8, 2025, at the Kamani Auditorium, New Delhi.

- The first Awards were given in 1955.
- The award includes an engraved copper plaque, a shawl, and a cash prize.
- The plaque was designed by the Indian filmmaker Satyajit Ray.

Om Prakash Chautala

Why in the news?

Om Prakash Chautala, former Chief Minister of Haryana and the leader of the Indian National Lok Dal (INLD), died.

Chautala, a seven-time MLA, served as the Chief Minister of Haryana for a record four terms, starting in December 1989, with his final term spanning from 1999 to 2005.
