#### BHARATPOL Portal

### Why in the news?

Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched the BHARATPOL portal developed by the Central Bureau of Investigation in New Delhi on 7th January 2025.

## About the portal:

- It will streamline the processing of all requests for international assistance through INTERPOL, including the issuance of Red Notices and other colour-coded INTERPOL notices.
- It will significantly facilitate Indian law enforcement agencies enabling real-time information sharing for faster access to international police assistance.

## Why was it needed?

- The growing footprint of transnational crimes including cybercrime, financial crimes, online radicalization, organized crimes, drug trafficking, and human trafficking, necessitates rapid and real-time international assistance in criminal investigations.
- By facilitating easier and faster access to international assistance, it will strengthen India's efforts in combating transnational crimes.







#### Jammu Railway Division

## Why in the news?

Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually inaugurated the Jammu Division of Indian Railways on 6th January 2025.

- It is the Indian Railways' 70th overall and the sixth under Northern Railways after Ambala, Delhi, Lucknow, Moradabad and Firozpur.
- The Railway Board has appointed E Srinivas as the first Divisional Railway Manager (DRM) of the Jammu Rail Division after its inauguration

## About the Jammu Railway Division:

\* The Jammu Division has a total rail network of 742.1 km, with sections such as Pathankot—Jammu—Udha—mpur—Srinagar—Baramulla (423 route km), Bhogpur—Sirwal—Pathankot (87.21 route km), Batala (excluding)—Pathankot (68.17 route km) and Pathankot—Joginder Nagar (narrow gauge section, 163.72 route km) coming under it.

#### 82nd Golden Globe Awards

## Why in the news?

The **82nd Golden Globe Awards** was hosted by comedian **Nikki Glaser** at the Beverly Hilton in Beverly Hills in California.

- The 82nd Golden Globes marked the first time when a woman solohosted the show.
- The French musical crime comedy, Emilia Perez, leads the pack with a stellar 10 nominations, including Best Motion Picture (Musical or Comedy), Best Director (Jacques Audiard), Best Actress (Karla Sofia Gascon), and Best Supporting Actress (Zoe Saldana and Selena Gomez).
  - The film took home four awards, including Best Picture, Best Supporting Actress (Zoe Saldana), Best Non-English Feature, and Best Original Song.
- The stellar run of A24 films continued with Brady Corbet's The Brutalist, which came a close second with seven nominations, and three wins for Best Actor (Adrien Brody), Best Director (Brady), and Best Movie (Drama).

Pope Francis appointed Sister Simona Brambilla to head the Vatican office that oversees religious orders for both men and women.

She is the first woman to reach the No.
