**Answer:**

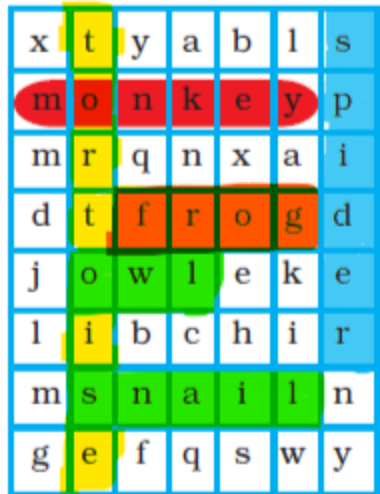
