 - (b) shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than three months but which may extend to two years and with fine.
 - (c) shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than six months but which may extend to two years and with fine.
 - (d) shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year but which may extend to two years and with fine.
