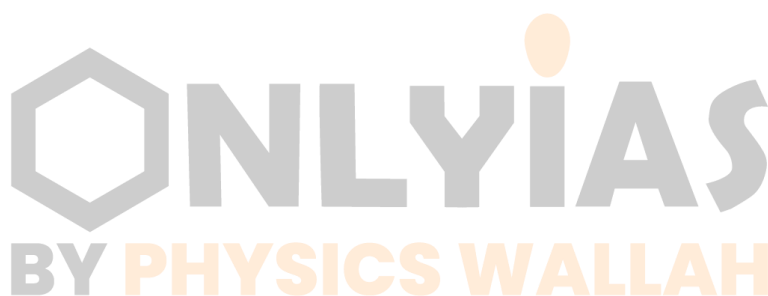
World Polio Day
