Why in the news?

Poorvi, a student of Bhavani Kanya Vidyalaya (Bhagalpur) has become the national champion in the Inspire Award standard.

Bhagalpur:

- India's only dolphin sanctuary is situated in the Bhagalpur district of Bihar.
- It is one of four Smart cities of Bihar: Patna, Muzaffarpur, Biharsarif and Bhagalpur.
- Jardalu Mango and Silk from Bhagalpur has got the GI tag,

6th EU-India Water Forum

Why in the news?

The 6th EU-India Water Forum was held on the sidelines of the 8th India Water Week in New Delhi.

It serves as a key platform for discussing water sector challenges, sharing best practices, and enhancing business and research opportunities. India and the European Union (EU) agreed to enhance cooperation in sustainable water management.

Key deliberations:

- Both sides committed to advancing cooperation in river basin management, fostering innovation and technology transfer while promoting sustainable investments.
- The forum explored trilateral collaboration between East Africa, India and the EU, to address challenges in East Africa's water bodies such as Lake Victoria and Lake Tanganyika.

India-EU Water Partnership (IEWP)

It was established in 2016 and aims to enhance technological, scientific, and policy frameworks in water management.

White Revolution 2.0

Why in the news?

Union Minister Amit Shah unveiled 'White Revolution 2.0', a comprehensive initiative aimed at empowering women farmers and creating job opportunities.

He launched the nationwide rollout of RuPay Kisan Credit Cards for dairy farmers and the installation of micro-ATMs at dairy cooperative societies





- Focus of the initiative:
 - > Empowering Women farmers.
 - > Enhancing local milk production.
 - > Strengthening dairy infrastructure.
 - > Boosting dairy exports.
- Objective of the scheme: Under White Revolution 2.0, the government aims to increase milk procurement by dairy cooperative societies by 50 percent over the next five years.
 - > It involves setting up and strengthening 100,000 new and existing district cooperative societies, multi-purpose district cooperative societies, and multi-purpose PACS.
 - National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) will fund the initiative from its resources, providing Rs 40,000 per M-PACS to 1,000 M-PACS.
 - Father of White Revolution: Dr Verghese Kurien
 - Operation Flood was launched on January 13, 1970 by NDDB.
- NDDB was established in 1965.

Launch of VisioNxt:

Union Minister of Textiles Shri Giriraj Singh launched VisioNxt, a bilingual web portal, and India Specific Fashion Trend Book Paridhi 24x25 on September 5, 2024.





Mission: To identify, map, and geo-specific analyse trends. reflecting India's positive plurality, cultural diversity, and socioeconomic nuances while collating comprehensive trends and insights.

- United Nations Human The Programme Settlements (UN-Habitat) facilitates the observance of the day.
 - > HQ of UN-Habitat: Nairobi, Kenya.
