Answer:

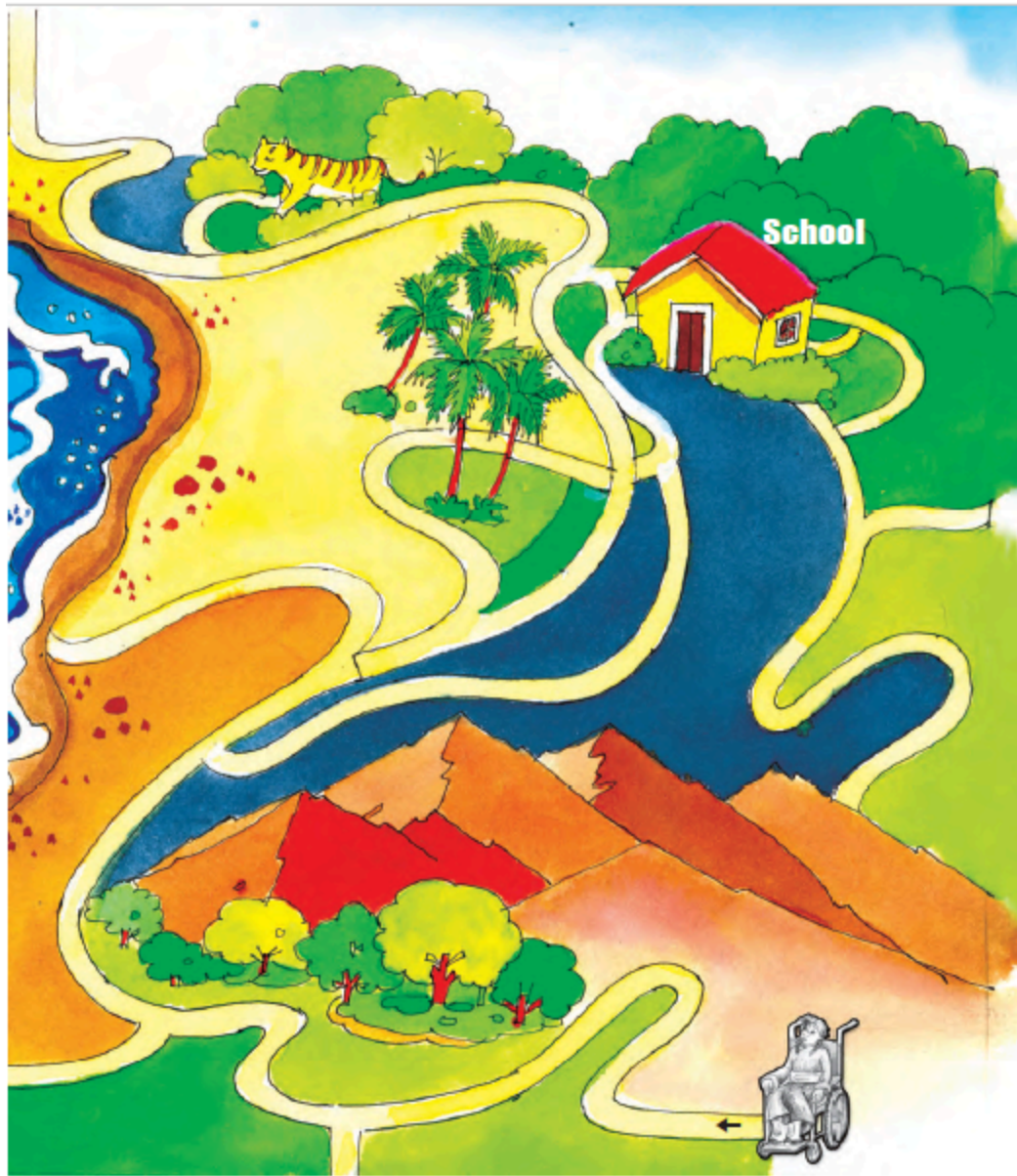

Answer:

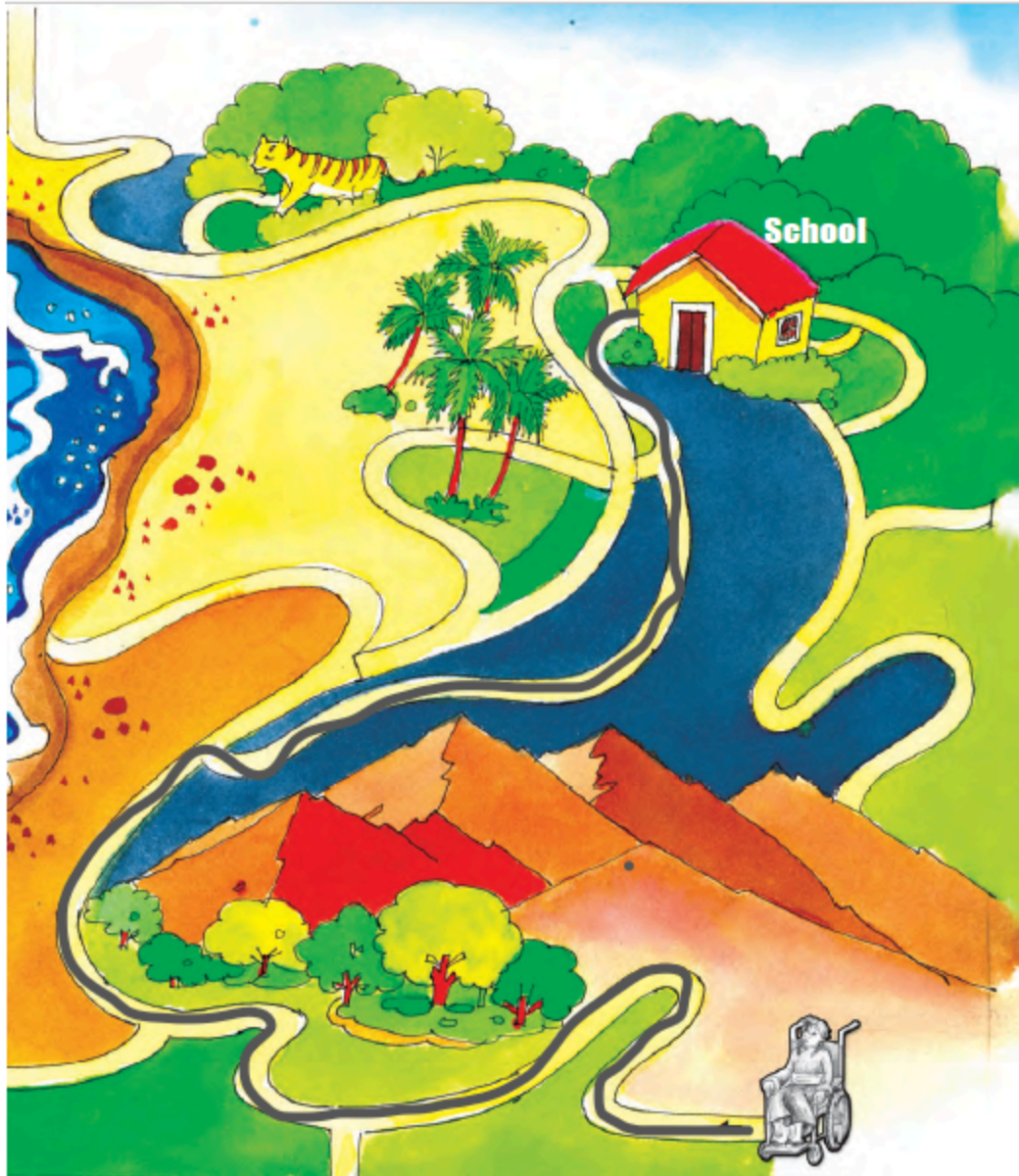
Yes, a wheelchair can go inside the building.
