Junior Asia Cup 2024

The Indian Men's Junior Hockey team defeated Pakistan 5-3 in the final of the 11th Men's Hockey Junior Asia Cup 2024, held on 4th December 2024 in Muscat, Oman.

Key Point


- India claimed the Men's Hockey Junior Asia Cup title for a record fifth time.
- The Indian team previously won this title in 2023, 2015, 2008, and 2004.
- The year 2024 has been remarkable for Indian men's hockey, with achievements including:
 - A bronze medal at the 2024 Paris Olympics.
 - Winning the Asian Men's Hockey Champions Trophy in China, also for a record fifth time.

Mahaparinirvan Diwas

The Mahaparinirvan Diwas 2024, which marks the 69th death anniversary of Babasaheb Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, will be observed by the Dr. Ambedkar Foundation (DAF) on behalf of the Union of Social Ministry Justice Empowerment at Prerna Sthal. Parliament House Complex, on December 6, 2024.



Key Point

Mahaparinirvan Diwas is observed annually on December 6 to commemorate the death anniversary of Bharat Ratna Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar, fondly known as Babasaheb Ambedkar.



- Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, born on April 14, 1891, in Mhow, Madhya Pradesh, dedicated his life to uplifting marginalized communities, especially Dalits, women, and labourers, who faced systemic social discrimination.
- As a social reformer, he launched the newspaper Mooknayaka (Leader of the Silent) to amplify the voices of the downtrodden.
- He established the Bahishkrit Hitkarini Sabha (Outcastes Welfare in Association) 1923 to spread economic education, improve conditions. address societal and inequalities.
- His leadership in historic movements such as the Mahad March (1927) for access to public water and the temple entry movement at Kalaram Temple (1930) challenged caste hierarchies and priestly dominance.
- Mahaparinirvan Diwas holds profound significance as a tribute to Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's transformative legacy.
- According to Buddhist texts, Lord Buddha's death is considered to be Mahaparinirvan, the Sanskrit term for 'nirvana after death'.
- Parinirvan is considered liberation from Samara, karma, and the cycle of death and birth. It is the most sacrosanct day in the Buddhist calendar.

International Cheetah Day

India celebrated International Cheetah Day on December 4 by releasing two male

cheetahs into Kuno National Park, located in the Sheopur district of Madhya Pradesh.



Key point

- The cheetahs, named Agni and Vayu, were reintroduced as part of ongoing conservation efforts.
- ❖ The release of the cheetahs took place in the Palpur East area, across the Kuno River, marking a significant milestone in India's cheetah reintroduction project aimed at restoring the cheetah population, which has been extinct in the country for nearly 70 years, and enhancing the region's biodiversity.
- At the moment there are 12 adult cheetahs and the same number of cubs in Kuno National Park totaling to 24 cheetahs making a success for the cheetah reintroduction program that started with the translocation of cheetahs from Namibia and South Africa facilitated by the Government of India and wildlife experts.
- To commemorate the occasion, the 2025 official calendar of Kuno National Park, featuring captivating photographs of cheetahs on Indian soil, was released in Palpur.



A short was launched on International Cheetah Day that showed about 2 years of the Project Cheetah with a video story on Bagcha – the last displaced village of the National Park.

The Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board also received the 'Best State Tourism Board' award, and the state was recognized with the Best State Award for promoting domestic tourism.

Drishti 10 'Starliner'

Adani Defence has handed over its second Drishti-10 Starliner surveillance drone to the Indian Navy, boosting India's maritime security capabilities.

Key Point

An indigenously manufactured Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) was launched by Adani Defence and Aerospace.



- Used as an improved platform for intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance (ISR).
- Has an endurance of 36hrs with a payload tolerance of 450 kilograms.
- It is suitable for day and night flying and certified for 'clear of clouds' as well as in categorised and uncertified airspace.
- Having been designed for high endurance, proven in combat, features, increasing the naval strength of India.
- Enhanced platform with the features of maintaining secure satellite communication and Line-of-Sight (LOS) data link system for efficient information transfer.
- Independent operations, with mission competency and adaptable payload configurations as important features, renders it a strategic operational tool.
- Less maintenance needs also support cost influence and maintainability.
