Explanation-

According to the second law of motion the rate of change of momentum is directly proportional to the force applied or exerted now as per the law when the fast moving ball is caught by the fielder in the ground than he takes some more time by pulling his hand backwards due to which the rate of change momentum decreases due to increase in time which in turn decreases the exerted force/ impact on the hands of fielder thus avoiding injuries when handling fast moving ball.

Hence, the answer is **option(B)i.e** 'Newton's second law of motion'.
