World Maritime Conference

Why in the news?



The World Maritime Technology conference (WMTC) is being held in Chennai from December 4 to 6, 2024.

- It is a triennial global event under the auspices of the World Maritime Technology Congress.
- It marks the return of the conference to India after a gap of 15 years, with the last edition hosted in Mumbai.
- The previous conference, which was delayed due to the Covid pandemic, was held in Copenhagen in April 2022.

Why in the news?

The University of Oxford has lauded India's PRAGATI initiative as a transformative model for governance.

It has urged the global community to learn from India's innovative approach.

About the study:

- In a study titled "From Gridlock to Growth: How Leadership Enables India's PRAGATI Ecosystem to Power Progress," the university highlighted the platform's role in revolutionizing project monitoring and resolution in India.
 - The report emphasizes PRAGATI's success in breaking bureaucratic inertia, fostering a "Team India" mindset, and instilling accountability and efficiency across central and state governments.
 - PRAGATI has enhanced social progress and environmental sustainability. Fast tracked projects providing essential services such as roads, railways, water, and electricity have improved the quality of life for millions.
- The Oxford report further notes that PRAGATI's lessons are particularly relevant for nations grappling with the Middle-Income Trap.





It demonstrates how governance innovation, combined with strategic infrastructure investments, can create conditions for sustained growth and progress. Following a public vote in which more than 37,000 people had their say, Oxford has announced "Brain rot" as Word of the Year for 2024.

PRAGATI

Brain rot

- PRAGATI stands for Pro-Active Governance and Timely Implementation and was launched in 2015.
- It is defined as "the supposed deterioration of a person's mental or intellectual state, especially viewed as the result of overconsumption of material (now particularly online content) considered to be trivial or unchallenging.
- It has redefined the management of large-scale infrastructure projects and social programs across the nation.
- The first recorded use of 'brain rot' was found in 1854 in Henry David Thoreau's book Walden, which reports his experiences of living a simple lifestyle in the natural world.
- The platform combines digital tools, real-time data, drone feeds, and video conferencing to expedite project timelines while ensuring development reaches even the remotest regions.
- The term increased in usage frequency by 230% between 2023 and 2024.



Letsile Tebogo and Sifan Hassan have been adjudged as the "World Athletes of the Year 2024" at the World Athletics Awards.

- Tebogo became Botswana's first Olympic champion at Paris 2024. Tebogo received his award after becoming Botswana's first Olympic champion at Paris 2024 in the 200m, crossing the line at the Stade de France in 19.46 seconds.
 - The 21-year-old was named Male World Athlete of the Year as well as Male Track Athlete of the Year.
- Dutchwoman Hassan collected the Female World Athlete of the Year award after winning her first global marathon title in the Paris Olympics in less than 18 months after claiming the 2023 London Marathon on debut.
 - Her Paris triumph made her the first athlete since Emil Zatopek to win medals in the 5000m, 10,000m and marathon at the same Games.
 - She also claimed the Female Out of Stadium Athlete of the Year award with Ethiopia's men's marathon gold medallist Tamirat Tola taking the men's equivalent.

World Athlete of the Year Awards

First awarded in 1988, the annual prize is given to the best male and female track and field athletes of that calendar year.

- She succeeded Chief Justice Jayantha Jayasuriya, who recently retired.
- She becomes the 48th Chief Justice of Sri Lanka and the second woman to hold this position.

International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD) is a global healthcare event observed every year on the 3rd of December.

History of this day:

- The annual observance of this day began in 1992, after it was proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly resolution 47/3.
- In 2006, the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) was also adopted.
- Theme 2024: "Amplifying the leadership of persons with disabilities for an inclusive and sustainable future".

 - It is celebrated on 3rd December to mark the birth anniversary of India's first president, Dr. Rajendra Prasad.
