DigiYatra App

Why in the news?

The Airport Authority of India (AAI) launched DigiYatra, a biometric-based smartphone application for airport entry, at nine airports.

The app was launched at Visakhapatnam, Patna, Raipur, Bhubaneswar, Goa (Dabolim), Indore, Ranchi, Coimbatore and Bagdogra airports.

DigiYatra app:

- DigiYatra app helps you to get rid of long queues waiting that form before entering the airports.
- The Digi Yatra app connects a traveler's boarding pass to a facial recognition system (FRS) for identity verification.
- This integration streamlines the process, reducing the time needed to reach the boarding gates and complete pre-security checks.

SURAKSHIT SAFAR SUVIDHA

Why in the news?

Bihar Police started a service named 'Surakshit Safar Suvidha' under a pilot project in 6 districts to make the journey of women safe.

- Bihar has become the third state in the country after Haryana and Telangana, where women will be tracked through GPS by dialing 112 on one call.
- This service will start in all the districts of Bihar on 15th September 2024 but currently, it has been started in 6 districts.
- 6 districts are- Patna, Nalanda, Bhagalpur, Gaya, Begusarai and Muzaffarpur.
- It was started from the Control and Command Center located in the Wireless Bhawan complex in Patna.

- The Nutrition Tracker ensures realtime monitoring and evaluation of children's nutritional development, contributing to a healthy future for children.

Poshan Tracker initiative

It is a tech tool to monitor Mission Poshan 2.0's progress, including growth measurements, Aadhar verification, and real-time tracking of nutrition services.







International Relations

First international AI treaty

Why in the news?

The European Union, United States, United Kingdom, and others signed the first international legally binding treaty on the use of artificial intelligence (AI) systems.

- The treaty was opened for signature at a Council of Europe conference in Vilnius, Lithuania.
- Signatory countries include Andorra, Georgia, Iceland, Norway, Moldova, San Marino, and Israel.
- Nations involved in negotiating the treaty also include Argentina, Australia, Canada, Costa Rica, the Vatican, Japan, Mexico, Peru, and Uruguay.

Council of Europe:

The Council of Europe is an organization based in Strasbourg, France is responsible for upholding human rights and consists of 47 member states, including the 27 member states of the EU.



ADNOC and ExxonMobil Partnership for Low-Carbon Hydrogen Facility

Why in the news?

The announcement of a partnership between Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC) and ExxonMobil to develop the world's largest low-carbon hydrogen facility.

- Location: The facility will be located in Baytown, Texas.
- * ADNOC's Stake: ADNOC will acquire a 35% equity stake in the project.
- Technology: The facility will use advanced carbon capture and storage technologies to remove approximately 98% of CO2 emissions.
- Production Capacity: It will produce up to 1 billion cubic feet of lowcarbon hydrogen daily and more than 1 million tons of low-carbon ammonia annually.



- The facility aims Impact: to decarbonize hard-to-abate sectors such industry, as energy, and transportation, and boost U.S. competitiveness in the low-carbon hydrogen market.
- * Timeline: The final investment decision is expected in 2025, with operations commencing by 2029.

- International Solar Alliance (ISA), established in 2015, now has 100 member countries, with 19 more nations ratifying the framework agreement for full membership.
- * Aims to highlight solar energy's transformative power in advancing Sustainable Development Goals and universal energy access.
