India: Third most Powerful Nation in the Asia

In the recently released Asia Power Index 2024, India has surpassed Japan to become the third most powerful country in the Asia Power Index.



Key Points-

- The Lowy Institute has released the 2024 Asia Power Index.
- In this, America is in first place with 81.7 points, China is in second place with 72.7 points, India is in third place with 39.1 points and Japan is in fourth place with 38.9 points.

Main factors behind the rise of India:

- ❖ Economic Growth: India has shown remarkable post-pandemic economic recovery, contributing to a 4.2-point rise in its Economic Capability. India's massive population and strong GDP growth reinforce its standing as the world's third-largest economy in PPP terms.
- Future Potential: India's Future Resources score increased by 8.2 points, signalling a potential demographic dividend. Unlike its regional competitors,

- particularly China and Japan, India benefits from a youthful population that will continue to drive economic growth and labour force expansion in the coming decades.
- Diplomatic Influence: Prime Minister * Narendra Modi's leadership has international garnered greater recognition. India's non-aligned strategic posture has allowed New Delhi to navigate complex international waters effectively. India ranked 6th in terms of diplomatic dialogues in 2023, reflecting its active engagement in multilateral forums.
- Further, India's large population and economic capabilities offer it substantial promise. India's score in Cultural Influence has also remained relatively strong, underpinned by its global diaspora and cultural exports.

About Index -

- It was first introduced by the Lowy Institute in 2018.
- The Asia Power Index evaluates 27 countries in the Asia-Pacific region based on their ability to influence and respond to external geopolitical problems.
- The index evaluates each country's strength using eight basic parameters, including diplomatic influence, military prowess, and economic capacity.

Shankh Air

India's newest airline Shankh Air has received approval from the Civil Aviation Ministry to operate in the country for three years.

Key Points-

- Location: Uttar Pradesh's first scheduled airline Shankh Air will have its hubs in Lucknow and Noida.
- Shank Air will be headquartered at Noida International Airport (NIA), Jewar and plans to connect all major metro cities in India from Lucknow and Noida.
- Aim: The airline aims to connect major cities across India, offering both intrastate and interstate routes, focusing on regions with high demand and limited direct flight options.

- Way forward: The airline will need approval from the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) before it can officially start flights.
- Launch: The airline will be ready for launch by the end of 2024.

Uttar Pradesh International Trade Show

Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar inaugurated the second edition of the 'Uttar Pradesh International Trade Show'.

Key Points -

- The second edition of UP International Trade Show is being organized from 25 to 29 September at India Expo Mart, Greater Noida.
- UP International Trade Show is working to bring artisans, craftsmen of the state and buyers from all over the world on one platform.
- 2,500 stalls of defense, agriculture, e-commerce, IT, GI, education, infrastructure, banking, financial services, dairy industry etc. have been set up in it.
- This year, 70 countries are expected to participate in UPITS and 4 lakh footfalls are expected. Apart from this, a fashion show of Khadi garments and cultural programs by artists will be performed in UPITS.

Highlights of the Vice President's address -

Uttar Pradesh's efforts to rapidly become an 'enterprise state' were also highlighted.



- UP is full of development and innovation activities in all sectors. In two years, the economy will surpass Germany and Japan to reach the third position.
- UP aspires to reach the target of one trillion dollars by 2027. The massive focus on infrastructure here makes it a powerful state.

Global Aerospace Summit

Key Points -

- The Summit brings together industry leaders, government officials and academia to discuss sustainability, youth engagement and innovation in the aerospace, space and defence sectors.
- * Focus Topics: Covers aerospace technology, policy, and investment, with a focus on emerging technologies such as AI, electric propulsion, and hydrogen-powered aircraft.
- The space economy is projected to reach \$1.8 trillion by 2035, growing at an average rate of 9% per year.
- * Background: Since its inception in 2012, the Summit has played a key role in the global aerospace sector.

In line with his commitment to make India self-reliant in the field of supercomputing technology, at Pune, Maharashtra, the Prime Minister dedicated to nation the three **PARAM** Rudra supercomputers, indigenously developed National under the Supercomputing Mission, costing about Rs 130 crore.
