Center approves 11 Kendriya Vidyalayas in Madhya Pradesh

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has approved the setting

up of 85 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs). Of these, 11 Kendriya Vidyalayas are from Madhya Pradesh.



Key Points

- Under the National Education Policy 2020, almost all Kendriya Vidyalayas have been designated as PMShri Schools, underscoring the implementation of NEP 2020 and serving as exemplary schools for others.
- Madhya Pradesh got 11 Kendriya Vidyalayas - Ashok Nagar District Ashok Nagar, Nagda District Ujjain, Maihar District Satna, Tirodi District Balaghat, Barghat District Seoni, Niwari District Niwari, Khajuraho District Chhatarpur, Jhinjhari District Katni, Sabalgarh District Morena, Narsinghgarh District Rajgarh and Central Academy Police Academy Kanhasaiya District Bhopal.

25 years of Hornbill Festival of Nagaland

The Hornbill Festival, a prominent cultural event in India, is marking its 25th edition in 2024. This annual celebration takes place in Kohima, Nagaland.



Key Points

- The Hornbill festival was launched in 2000 by the Nagaland government as a celebration of Naga culture.
- The Hornbill Festival, also famous as the "Festivals of Festivals", derives its name from the elusive Hornbill bird.
- This year the international partners of the Hornbill festival are the United Kingdom, United States, Japan, and Peru.
- The partner state of this year's Hornbill festival is Sikkim.
- The Hornbill Festival is jointly organised by the State government's Tourism and Art & Culture Department at the Kisama Heritage Village.

Government launches SCAN Portal to streamline PDS system

The Ministry Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, government of India has launched SCAN (Subsidy Claim Application for NFSA) Portal and 'Anna Chakra'' to modernise the Public

Distribution
System in the country.





Key Points

- The SCAN Portal and the Anna Chakra tool is expected to increase the efficiency of the world's largest public distribution system.
- The SCAN (Subsidy Claim Application for NFSA) Portal is a single window system for settlement of claims of subsidy under the Public Distribution System.

About Anna Chakra

- Anna Chakra is a pioneering tool for optimizing the supply chain of the PDS in India.
- It has been developed in collaboration with the World Food Programme (WFP) and the Foundation for Innovation and Technology Transfer (FITT) at IIT-Delhi.
- This initiative employs advanced algorithms to identify optimal routes for the transportation of food grains.

Public Distribution System

- The PDS is an Indian food Security System established to address food scarcity by providing foodgrains at affordable prices
- It operates under the National Food Security Act (NFSA), 2013, ensuring food security for nearly two-thirds of India's population based on Census 2011 data.

- The Public Distribution System (PDS) in India originated during World War II as a wartime rationing measure and evolved through several phases.
- In the 1960s, PDS expanded in response to food shortages, with the establishment of the Agriculture Prices Commission and the FCI to ensure domestic procurement and storage.
- By the 1970s, PDS became a universal scheme, and in 1992, the Revamped Public Distribution System (RPDS) aimed to strengthen and expand PDS reach in remote areas.
- The Targeted Public Distribution

 System (TPDS), launched in 1997,
 focused on the poor by categorizing
 beneficiaries into Below Poverty Line

 (BPL) and Above Poverty Line (APL)
 households.
- The Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY), launched in 2000, further targeted the poorest families.

Armed Forces Flag Day 2024

India celebrates Armed Forces Flag Day annually on December 7 to honour the

valor, sacrifices, and dedication of the Indian Armed Forces.





Key Points

- The observance of Armed Forces Flag Day began on December 7, 1949, under the aegis of the Defence Ministry.
- The day was established to collect funds through the distribution of symbolic flags, highlighting the sacrifices made by the military and raising awareness about their welfare.
- In 1993, the Ministry of Defence unified various welfare funds, including those for war victims, exservicemen, and the Kendriya Sainik Board, into a single Armed Forces Flag Day Fund.

Sri Lanka's Shammi Silva Takes Over Asian Cricket Council Presidency Role

Sri Lanka's Shammi Silva has taken over as the president of the Asian Cricket

Council (ACC), succeeding India's Jay Shah.



Key Points

- Sri Lanka's Shammi Silva has taken over as the president of the Asian Cricket Council (ACC), succeeding India's Jay Shah, who recently became the chairman of the International Cricket Council (ICC).
- Jay Shah assumed the office of International Cricket Council (ICC) chairman, replacing Greg Barclay.

- Shah had vacated the position after three terms as ACC President.
- Shammi Silva has previously functioned as the chairman of the organisation's Finance & Marketing Committee.

RBI Keeps Repo Rate Unchanged


The RBI maintained the repo rate at 6.5% for the 11th consecutive time, signaling a neutral policy stance.

Key Points

The Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) was cut by 50 basis points to 4%, releasing ₹1.16 trillion in liquidity to address tight liquidity conditions.

GDP and Inflation Outlook:

- ❖ FY 2024-25 GDP growth forecast lowered to 6.6% from 7.2%.
- Inflation projection raised to 4.8%, with easing food inflation expected from Q4.
- Monetary Policy Committee Votes: Two external members supported a 25 bps rate cut, indicating potential easing in February 2025.
