### Paris Paralympics 2024

Preethi Pal became the first Indian woman to win two Paralympic medals in track and field events at Paris Paralympics 2024. She won bronze in the women's 200m T35 class with a personal best time of 30.01 seconds. Earlier, she had secured another bronze in the 100m T35 class at the same event.



Yogesh Kathuniya secured his second Paralympic medal, winning silver in the men's discus throw F56 event on Monday in Paris.

Nitesh Kumar captured gold in the men's singles SL3 badminton event at the Paris Paralympics on Monday in Paris.

Javelin star Sumit Antil secured his second consecutive Paralympic gold with an outstanding performance on Monday in Paris.
