MoU with ISRO

Why in the news?

Bihar has achieved a milestone in disaster management with the signing of a tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in Ahmedabad on 11th January 2025.

About the MoU:

- It was finalized between the Bihar State Disaster Management Authority (BSDMA), the Bihar Mausam Seva Kendra (BMSK), and the Space Applications Centre (SAC), a key institution of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).
- The agreement aims to enhance Bihar's capacity to monitor and predict disasters such as floods, droughts, heatwaves, cold waves, lightning, and even earthquakes.
- * Satellite data will be used to provide early warnings and improve response strategies. Remote sensing technology will allow for the estimation of river depths and water flow, helping mitigate flood damage.





Additionally, the MoU includes provisions for research and education, enabling students from Bihar pursuing higher studies to collaborate with SAC and ISRO for academic and scientific exploration.

Bihar State Disaster Management Authority (BSDMA)

- It is a statutory body created under the provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 passed by the Parliament.
 - Bihar SDMA was set up vide notification No. 3449 on 6th Nov' 2007, under Section 14 (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 passed by the Parliament.
- It is chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, a Vice-Chairman and other members.
- Objectives of BSDMA are:
 - Lay down the State Disaster Management Policy.
 - Approve the State DM Plan.
 - Approve the DM Plans prepared by the departments of the Government of Bihar.

- Law down guidelines to be followed by the Deptt. of the Government of the State for mainstreaming.
- Recommend provision of funds for mitigation and preparedness measures.
- Coordinate the implementation of the State Plan.

Bharat Cleantech Manufacturing
Platform at the **Bharat Climate Forum**2025 in New Delhi.

- It aims to enhance India's cleantech value chains in sectors like solar, wind, hydrogen, and battery storage.
- It also aims to encourage the cleantech sector to become selfsustaining without relying on government support in the long term.

Key Highlights of the Platform:

- Objective: To spur innovation and help India become a global leader in sustainability and cleantech.
- Product-Linked Incentives (PLIs): Shri Goyal emphasized that while PLIs can kickstart the sector, longterm growth requires the cleantech sector to become self-sustaining.
- Collaboration: The platform will provide opportunities for Indian firms to collaborate, co-innovate, and share ideas, technologies, and resources.
- Climate Goals: India aims to achieve 500 Gigawatts of clean energy sources by 2030, and the platform is expected to play a crucial role in meeting this target.

- India's active engagement in the Committee of Experts will highlight its pioneering initiatives, including establishing the Data Innovation Lab and exploring alternate data sources.

About the Committee:

The UN Committee of Experts on Big Data and Data Science for Official Statistics was created to investigate further the benefits and challenges of Big Data, including the potential for monitoring and reporting on sustainable development goals.

HimKavach

Why in the news?

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has developed the 'HimKavach' clothing system.

- * Objective: To protect soldiers operating in extreme cold conditions.
 - It is designed to function in temperatures ranging from 20°C to -60°C, has passed all user trials in operational settings.

About the HimKavach:

- It is made up of multiple layers, each tailored for insulation, breathability, and comfort.
- The modular design allows soldiers to add or remove layers depending on the weather.
 - This feature is seen as critical for troops operating in the Himalayas, where temperatures can drop sharply.

World Economic Situation and Prospects Report 2025






The United Nations has released the "World Economic Situation and Prospects Report 2025".

About the report:

- It has pegged the global economic growth forecast at 2.8% for 2025 and 2.9% for 2026, largely unchanged from previous years.
- It has projected a slight improvement in growth for least developed countries (LDCs) in 2025, slower global growth than the pre-pandemic average of 3.2%.
- A fall in global inflation from 4% in 2024 to 3.4% in 2025, driven by easing labour market pressures in developed economies and moderating international food and energy commodity prices.

The National Youth Day or Rashtriya Yuva Divas is celebrated on 12th January every year.

- History of this day:
 - In 1984, the Government of India declared the birthday of the Hindu monk Swami Vivekanand as National Youth Day.
 - Since January 12, 1985, the day has been celebrated in India every year as National Youth Day.
- Theme 2025: Youth for a Sustainable Future: Shaping the Nation with Resilience and Responsibility.

Swami Vivekananda


- He was born as Narendranath Datta in Kolkata on 12th January, 1863.
- He was a philosopher, author, and religious teacher, credited for raising interfaith awareness and bringing Hinduism to the world's major religions.
- His iconic speech in Chicago in 1893, where he introduced Hinduism to the world, still fills the country's youth with pride.

- He was chief disciple of the Indian mystic Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa, Swamiji even introduced Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world.
- He died at the young age of 39, on
 4 July 1902.
