Prime Minister to visit Guyana

Why in the news?

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Guyana becoming the first Indian Prime Minister to visit the South American nation in 56 years.



- Significance of the visit— The visit highlights the growing Indian diaspora in Guyana and the shared enthusiasm to deepen bilateral relations.
- CARICOM-India Summit: PM Modi will co-chair the summit with Grenada's PM Dickon Mitchell to enhance collaboration in areas like energy, infrastructure, agriculture, health, and technology.
- Global South Initiative: India's active engagement with CARICOM is part of its "Voice of Global South" initiative launched during its G20 presidency.
- Bilateral Frameworks: Relations are supported by cultural exchanges, a business council, and joint ministerial commissions, with collaboration in agriculture, IT, biofuels, energy, and pharmaceuticals.

Why in the news?







The Guru Ghasidas-Tamor Pingla Tiger Reserve in Chhattisgarh has been notified as the 56th Tiger Reserve of the country.

- It spans 2,829 sq. km, with a critical tiger habitat covering 2,049.2 sq. km and a buffer zone of 780.15 sq. km.
- The reserve includes Guru Ghasidas National Park and Tamor Pingla Wildlife Sanctuary.
- It is the country's third largest tiger reserve after Nagarjunasagar-Srisailam Tiger Reserve in Andhra Pradesh and Manas Tiger Reserve in Assam.


Commemorative Postage Stamp on Sickle
Cell Eradication – 2047

Why in the news?

On the occasion of Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas on 15th November 2024, the Governor of Madhya Pradesh, Shri Mangubhai Patel, and Chief Minister Shri Mohan Yadav unveiled a commemorative postage stamp dedicated to "Sickle Cell Eradication - 2047" at PG College, Dhar.

Eradication Mission:

- Emphasizes genetic counseling, community screening, and use of advanced diagnostics like HPLC machines.
- Specialized lab at AIIMS Bhopal for newborn testing and prenatal diagnostics in collaboration with Sankalp India.
- National Sickle Cell Portal and mobile app for disease tracking and reporting.
- * This commemorative stamp honors the State's initiative to combat the high prevalence of sickle cell anemia in tribal regions and highlights the commitment to eradicate this hereditary disease by 2047.
- The Sickle Cell Eradication Mission was launched in phases, initially covering districts like Alirajpur and Jhabua and later expanding to 17 states across India.

Magnus Carlsen clinched the **blitz title** at the Tata Steel Chess India tournament in Kolkata, achieving a double victory in both rapid and blitz formats.

- This marks Carlsen's second double win in Kolkata, replicating his 2019 feat.
- Indian players performed admirably, with Erigaisi taking third place with 10.5 points, R Praggnanandhaa finishing fourth on 9.5, and Vidit Gujrathi rounding out the top five with 9 points.


- Dr. Madan Choudhary was elected
