Key Point

25th Session of the India-Russia Intergovernmental Commission on Trade

EAM S Jaishankar highlights need to strengthen trade ties between India, Russia at India-Russia Business Forum



Key Point

- The India-Russia Business Forum was organized in Mumbai, which was participated by Russia's First Deputy PM Denis Manturov.
- At present the total trade between India and Russia is \$ 66 billion, and both the countries by strategically increasing their bilateral trade want to cross the \$100 billion mark by 2030.
- The discussion of the forum mainly revolved around the enhancement of the trade partnership through the issues of transport, banking and, financial transactions.

Hurun India Philanthropy List 2024

The EdelGive-Hurun India Philanthropy List 2024 has been released.



Key Points

Shiv Nadar, the founder of HCL Technologies, has retained his position as India's most generous philanthropist for the third time in

- five years. He donated Rs 2.153 crore in the financial year 2024 (translating to Rs 5.9 crore every single day).
- * Rohini Nilekani, co-founder of Infosys and wife of Nandan Nilekani, took the lead as the most generous woman on the list with an annual donation of Rs 154 crore.
- Nikhil Kamath, co-founder of Zerodha, has become the youngest philanthropist featured in the EdelGive-Hurun India Philanthropy List 2024 at just 38 years old.
- Mumbai remained the city with the highest concentration of philanthropists in the list, accounting for 30% of the total, followed by New Delhi at 19%, and Bengaluru at 9%.

4th edition of AIM-ICDK Water Innovation Challenge

The fourth edition of the AIM-ICDK Water Innovation Challenge 4.0 successfully concluded at the 2024 Next Generation Digital Action (NGDA) in Copenhagen, Denmark, marking a

significant achievement in the growing Indo-Danish Green Strategic Partnership.



Key Point

This year's challenge reinforced its position as a premier platform for fostering innovative and sustainable solutions to global water issues.



- The challenge brought together key collaborators, including Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog, Innovation Centre Denmark (ICDK), and DTU Skylab under the DTU Next Action Generation Program, alongside invaluable support from the International Centre for Clean Water (ICCW), the Ministry of Jal Shakti, the Embassy of Denmark, Denmark's Environmental Protection Agency, and the DANIDA Fellowship.
- The partnership between India and Denmark has proven instrumental in driving impactful innovation.
- The AIM-ICDK Water Innovation Challenge has been particularly effective in empowering young innovators from both countries to address urgent environmental challenges

Atal Innovation Mission (AIM): It is a flagship initiative launched to promote the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship in the country.

COP29 opens in Baku, Azerbaijan

The 29th annual UN Climate Change Conference, COP29, held at Baku in Azerbaijan.





Key Point

- COP 29 refers to the 29th annual Conference of the Parties to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change.
- This event started in Baku, Azerbaijan from 11-24 November 2024.
- COP stands for Conference of the Parties, with "parties" referring to the 197 nations that agreed to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
- It is the apex decision-making body of UNFCCC.
- * It reviews the national commitments and emission inventories submitted by Parties. Based on this information, the COP assesses the progress made in achieving the ultimate objective of the Convention.

About United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC)

- The UNFCCC, signed in 1992 at the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development also known as the Earth Summit, the Rio Summit, or the Rio Conference.
- The UNFCCC entered into force on March 21, 1994.
- The Convention has near universal membership (197 Parties).
- Secretariat: Bonn, Germany.
