CAT Topic Wise Weightage

On observing the question papers of the last 3 years, it is evident that IIMs have started giving higher weightage to some topics over the others. Reading Comprehension and Arithmetic alone account for more than 40% weightage in CAT syllabus. Some topics have not been asked in the last 2 years like calendars,

clocks, trigonometry, error detection, cloze tests, etc. CAT topic wise weightage is provided below for the CAT aspirants.

Arithmetic (Profit & Loss, Mixtures, Time Speed & Distance, Averages, Interest) 17%
Data Interpretation Sets (Combination, Bar Graphs, Tables) 16%
Logical Reasoning Sets 16%
Verbal Ability (Summary, Parajumbles, and Odd Sentence Out) 12%
Geometry, Mensuration, Number System, Modern Math 9%
Algebra 8%

VARC Syllabus for CAT

VARC Syllabus for CAT is now primarily focused on 5 topics- para jumbles, para completion, para summary, odd sentence out, and reading comprehension. Your preparation should be focused around these 5 topics of VARC CAT syllabus - know the type of questions asked in previous years, how to

approach these questions for accuracy, and the important CAT English syllabus topics required to attempt these questions. The topic wise weightage of VARC syllabus for CAT is provided here:

DILR Syllabus for CAT

DILR Syllabus for CAT is further divided into 2 sections- logical reasoning and data interpretation. To cover the DILR Syllabus for CAT, daily practice is the most important aspect. CAT syllabus for logical reasoning includes the topics tabulated below. In CAT question paper, you will find question sets from 2-3 of these 10 topics. The most prominent among these are seating arrangement, blood relations, and logical puzzles.

CAT Syllabus for Data Interpretation includes a basic understanding of the types of graphs, charts, diagrams and how to calculate the required values from the given data. • DILR CAT questions are also framed on the basis of data presented in tables and paragraphs.

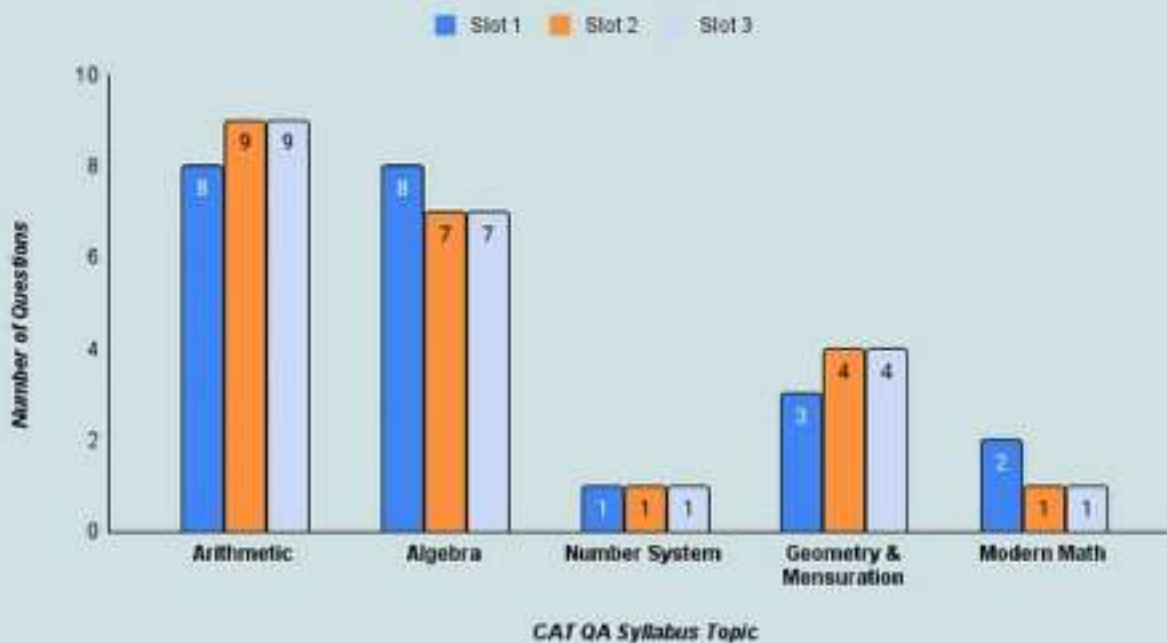
- The most asked form of question is a combination of 2 or more types of data representation.

Quantitative Aptitude Syllabus for CAT

CAT Syllabus for Quantitative Aptitude is based on the topics of maths syllabus.

Arithmetic accounts for more than 50% of the questions asked from CAT QA Syllabus. The major topics included are profit, loss & discount, time speed & distance, mixtures, average, work, percentage, ratio & proportion, and SI/ CI. The topic wise weightage of QA syllabus for CAT is provided here:

CAT Exam Pattern

CAT Exam Pattern has undergone major changes in the last 3 years. From 2015-19, CAT exam had 100 questions to be attempted in 180 minutes.

In 2020, the pattern of CAT question paper was revised due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The number of questions was reduced to just 76 and time to 120 minutes.

- In 2021, the number of questions was further reduced by 10 to 66.
- CAT exam 2022 was also as per the revised pattern of 2021.
