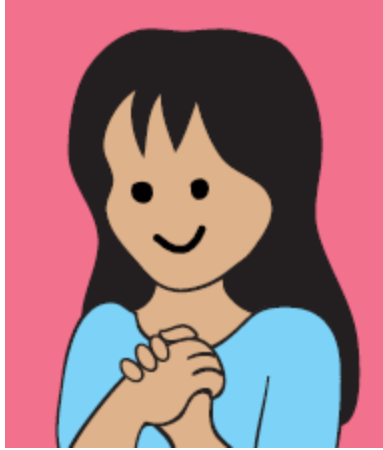
They use hand gestures and facial expressions to communicate.
