Global Soil Conference 2024 Inaugurated in New Delhi

Key Points:

- The four-day Global Soils Conference 2024 was inaugurated in New Delhi on 19 November 2024 and will be held from 19 to 22 November 2024.
- The conference, which is the apex global platform for world soil scientists and stakeholders, provides a platform for the stakeholders- government, scientists, industry leaders, farmers, etc. to discuss various issues regarding the importance of soils and to find a solution to concerns about the issue of soil degradation and its sustainable management.



Organizer of the Global Soil Conference 2024

The Global Soils Conference is being organised by the Indian Society of Soil Science, New Delhi, under the aegis of the International Union of Soil Sciences, Italy, with the collaboration of the New Delhibased Indian Council of Agricultural Research and the National Academy of Agricultural Science.

UAE Launches Global Energy Efficiency Alliance at COP29

Key Points:

- The UAE has unveiled an ambitious initiative to establish the 'Global Energy Efficiency Alliance' during COP29, hosted in Azerbaijan. This move aims to double global energy efficiency rates by 2030 and contribute to significant emission reductions.
- The initiative builds on the 'UAE ConseFnsus' from COP28, a commitment that brought together countries, organizations, and corporations to reduce

- carbon emissions and promote sustainable resource management.
- The UAE plans to lead the alliance by sharing its expertise in energy efficiency, fostering knowledge transfer, and building effective partnership models with the private sector.
- The alliance is designed to support the reduction of carbon emissions and the sustainable use of natural resources through knowledge sharing, capacity building, and standardization efforts.

18 – 24 November – World Antimicrobial Resistance Awareness Week

Key Points:

- World Antimicrobial Awareness Week (WAAW) is celebrated every year from November 18-24. Objective – To increase awareness of global antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and to encourage best practices.
- Theme 2024 Advocate. Act now As per the WHO, an estimated 1.27 million global deaths in 2019 were directly the result of bacterial AMR, and it also contributed to 4.95 million deaths.

Russia and Ukraine reaches its 1,000th day Key Points:

- As the conflict between Russia and Ukraine reaches its 1,000th day, the war stands as Europe's deadliest since World War II, leaving human and economic scars on both sides.
- Civilians have borne the brunt of the war, with the United Nations reporting at least 11,743 deaths and over 24,600 injuries as of August 2024.
- Ukrainian prosecutors say of the casualties, 589 children. Officials warn the true toll is likely much higher due to limited access to areas under Russian control.



Beyond the battlefield, the war has upended Ukraine's demographics. More than 6 million Ukrainians have fled abroad, while nearly 4 million remain internally displaced. The United Nations estimates Ukraine's population has shrunk by 10 million—a quarter of its pre-war total.





Territorial Shifts

- Russia now occupies roughly a fifth of Ukraine, an area comparable to Greece. This includes much of the Donbas region and the entire Sea of Azov coastline.
- Early in the conflict, Russian forces captured swathes of territory, but Ukrainian counteroffensives have since slowed the advance.
- Frontline cities such as Mariupol have been devastated, with many rendered uninhabitable. In the past year, Russia has consolidated gains in the Donbas, while Ukraine launched limited attacks, including

a cross-border operation into Russia's Kursk region.

Economic Fallout

- The war has significantly weakened Ukraine's economy, which contracted by a third in 2022 and remains 22% below prewar levels despite modest recovery.
- Damage to infrastructure reached \$152 billion by late 2023, according to assessments by the World Bank and other organisations, with total recovery costs estimated at \$486 billion.
- Ukraine's energy infrastructure has suffered repeated attacks, straining its capacity to meet civilian and industrial needs. Meanwhile, the disruption of Ukraine's grain exports early in the war exacerbated global food insecurity, though exports have since partially recovered.

- The Indira Gandhi Prize recognizes outstanding individuals or organizations that have made exceptional contributions to international peace, disarmament, and development. It is one of the highest honors in the field of peace and development.

Prize Details

- The award carries a monetary reward of 25 lakh rupees.
- It is accompanied by a citation recognizing the recipient's contributions.

Categories

- The Indira Gandhi Prize is awarded in three key categories:
- 1. Peace: Recognizing efforts to promote peace and resolve conflicts globally.
- 2. Disarmament: Honoring contributions towards reducing arms and promoting nuclear disarmament.

Which Ministry has launched the Campaign?

- The Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Union Ministry of Jal Shakti, has launched the three-week Hamara Shauchalay: Hamara Samman.
- The responsibility for implementing the Swachh Bharat Mission-Grameen component of the Swachh Bharat Mission lies with the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Union Ministry of Jal Shakti.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced a nationwide sanitation campaign on 15 August 2014, and the Swachh Bharat Mission was formally launched on 2 October 2014 Swachh Bharat Mission is being implemented in both rural and urban areas, respectively called Swachh Bharat Mission-Grameen and Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban.
- Union Ministry for Housing and Urban Affairs is the nodal agency that implements the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban.

Aim of the Hamara Shauchalay: Hamara Samman Campaign

- The campaign will affirm the country's commitment to behavioural change regarding sanitation.
- Maintaining the country's Open Defecation-Free (ODF) status and achieving the Phase II goal of the Swachh Bharat Mission(Grameen).



- In 2019, Phase II of the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) was launched.
- It focuses on total Sampoorn Swachhata sustaining the ODF status, managing solid and liquid waste by 2024-25, and transforming all the villages from ODF to ODF Plus Model.
- The campaign will focus on empowering vulnerable groups, especially women and girls, and will involve all stakeholders from village panchayat to State levels.

World Toilet Day

The first Toilet Day was observed in 2001 by the World Toilet Organisation. In 2013, the United Nations adopted 19 November as the World Toilet Day.

- World Toilet Day celebrates the importance of toilets and sanitation and seeks to raise global awareness about people without access to safely managed sanitation and the need to take action to solve this problem.
- The Day also raises awareness worldwide to achieve Sustainable Development Goal
 water and sanitation for all by 2030.

The United Nations agency UN Water selects the annual World Toilet Day theme. The theme for the 2024 World Toilet Day is 'Sanitation for Peace.'
