International Relations

11th D-8 Summit

Why in the news?

The 11th summit meeting of the Developing Eight (D-8) Organization for Economic Cooperation was held in the New Administrative Capital of Egypt on 19 December 2024.

- The New Administrative Capital of Egypt is being built on the outskirts of the present capital city of Cairo, and it is intended to be the new capital of Egypt.
- The 10th summit meeting of D-8 countries was held in Dhaka, Bangladesh, on 8th April 2021.

- ❖ Indonesia will host the 12th D-8 summit meeting in 2025.
- ❖ The theme of the 11th D-8 Summit meeting was "Investing in Youth and Supporting Small and Medium Enterprises: Towards Shaping the Economy of Tomorrow."
- The Egyptian government hosted the 11th D-8 Summit Meeting, which was inaugurated by Egyptian President Abdel Fattah Al-Sisi.

About D-8 Organization

- The D-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation is a multilateral forum of eight Islamic countries: Egypt, Bangladesh, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nigeria, Iran, Pakistan, and Turkiye.
- It was officially set up in June 1997 at the summit meeting of the Heads of State/Government of the eight countries in Istanbul, Turkiye.



1,000 MT of humanitarian aid to Lesotho

Why in the news?

India has extended humanitarian assistance to Lesotho, a country in Southern Africa.





- A consignment of one thousand metric tonnes has departed from Nhava Sheva Port for Lesotho.
- The consignment would help in addressing food security and nutritio nal requirements of the people of that country.

NITI Aayog releases Report on 'SAFE'

Why in the news?

Recently NITI Aayog released a report on the Site Adjacent Factory Employee (S.A.F.E.) Accommodation—Worker Housing for Manufacturing Growth in New Delhi.

- The report explores the crucial role of secure, affordable, flexible, and efficient accommodations for industrial workers in boosting India's manufacturing sector.
- It identifies key challenges, offers actionable solutions, and highlights the pivotal interventions required to scale up such housing facilities across the country.



- Development of dormitory-style rental housing for industrial workers under a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model.
- Funding and Support Supported through Viability Gap Funding (VGF) and commitments from anchor industries.

About SAFE

- It includes rented, long-term dormitory-style accommodation, exclusively for workers in industries, strategically located near workplaces.
- It includes essential amenities such as water, electricity, etc., and excludes family housing.
- Ownership of these units cannot be transferred or sold to workers or employers.

Para Athletics World Championships
2025

Why in the news?

The Para Athletics World Championships, the world's largest single Para sport event, will be held at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium from 26 September to 5 October 2025.

- New Delhi 2025 will mark the 12th edition of the championships and the fourth time it is hosted in Asia, following Doha 2015, Dubai 2019 and Kobe 2024.
- Doha, Qatar, was the first Asian city to host the World Para Athletics Championships in 2015.
- Dubai, UAE, hosted it in 2019, and Kobe, Japan, hosted the Championships in 2024.
- New Delhi will host the 12th World Para Athletics Championships from 26 September -5 October 2025 at the JawaharLal Nehru Stadium.
- The World Para Athletics has also awarded the World Para Athletics Grand Prix to New Delhi. It will be held at the JawaharLal Nehru Stadium from 11-13 March 2025.
