Mukhyamantri Vahan Chalak Kalyan Yojna-2024

Why in the news?

The Bihar cabinet has approved a proposal from the state transport department about the launch of the Mukhyamantri Vahan Chalak Kalyan Yojna-2024.

Objective of the scheme: For the welfare of commercial vehicle drivers who are natives of Bihar and have obtained driving licenses from the state.

Key provisions of the scheme:

- Under the scheme:
 - Commercial vehicle drivers will be insured and will get several other benefits, like training, regular health checkups, etc.
 - They will have to first get themselves registered and will be provided unique identification numbers.
- In case of fatalities, their next of kin will get financial benefits and other facilities.

Economy

Monetary Policy Committee

Why in the news?

The Reserve Bank of India has reconstituted the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) as per section 45ZB of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.

About the Committee:

- As per the provisions of the RBI Act, the committee consists of six members: three Members from RBI, and three are appointed by the Central Government.
- The MPC will have the following members:
 - > Chairperson: Governor of the Reserve Bank of India.
 - Member: Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India, in charge of Monetary Policy.
 - One officer of the Reserve Bank of India to be nominated by the Central Board.
 - Member: Prof. Ram Singh, Director, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi.





- Member: Saugata Bhattacharya,
 Economist
- Member: Dr. Nagesh Kumar, Director and Chief Executive, Institute for Studies in Industrial Development, New Delhi.

* Appointment of members:

- The RBI appoints three representatives, including the governor, while the remaining three members are external appointees.
- A selection panel comprising RBI Governor, Cabinet Secretary, and Economic Affairs Secretary is responsible for choosing the external members of the MPC.
- The final approval for these positions lies with the Prime Minister's office.

* Tenure of Members:

The members of the committee appointed by the Central Government shall hold office for a period of four years, with immediate effect or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

Inflation Targeting by committee:

It follows a CPI-based inflation targeting framework and is currently aiming to keep inflation at 4 percent, allowing for a tolerance range of ±2 percentage points.

Environment And Geography

New species of invasive flatworm

Why in the news?

A new species of invasive flatworm has been discovered in the United States and has been found in several states of the south USA.

About the species:

- The species, named Amaga pseudobama, was discovered by an international team of researchers and first spotted in 2020 in North Carolina.
 - It is thought to be native to South America.
 - Apart from North Carolina, the species is also present in Florida and Georgia and may have already invaded other states





Significance: This new species joins other invasive flatworm species discovered in the southern United States, including Platydemus manokwari.



Defence And Security

Navika Sagar Parikrama II

Why in the news?

The Indian Naval Sailing Vessel (INSV)

Tarini sailed for the second edition of a landmark global circumnavigation mission named Navika Sagar Parikrama II.

- The expedition was flagged off from the Naval Ocean Sailing Node at INS Mandovi, Goa on 2nd October 2024.
- Significance:
 - This landmark event marks a significant milestone in Naval Ocean sailing history as the first ever circumnavigation of the globe onboard a sailing vessel by Indian women in double-handed mode.

✓ Lt Cdr Dilna and Lt Cdr Roopa will carry forward a legacy established by Captain Dilip Donde, the first Indian to circumnavigate the globe in 2009-10, and Cdr Abhilash Tomy, who became the first Asian skipper to complete the prestigious Golden Globe Race in 2022.

- History of this mission:
 - It was first conceived in 2017 when an all-women crew of six Indian Navy officers successfully circumnavigated the globe.

About the mission:

- * It will cover more than 21,600 nautical miles (approx 40,000 km) and will unfold in five legs with stopovers at four ports for replenishment and maintenance, as required. The broad contour of voyage will be as follows:
 - > Goa to Fremantle, Australia
 - Fremantle to Lytteton, New Zealand
 - > Lyttleton to Port Stanley, Falkland
 - Port Stanley to Cape Town, S
 Africa
 - Cape Town to Goa

World's oldest eyeliner

Why in the news?

Archaeologists have unearthed the oldest eyeliner from the ruins of a prehistoric city in Turkey.

Significance: It has proved that humans were using makeup more than 8,000 years ago.

About the eyeliner:

- The kohl stick, which is a kind of eyeliner still popular among people, was found in Yeşilova Höyük which is an ancient settlement in western Turkey.
 - It is made using green serpentine stone and there are traces of black paint on its tip, more than 8,200 years after it was used.

It is nearly 10 cm long and a centimeter thick and is among various artefacts developed by the people of Yeşilova Höyük in ancient times.

Kho Kho World Cup, 2025

Why in the news?

India will host the first-ever Kho Kho World Cup in 2025 as per an announcement by the Kho Kho Federation of India (KKFI) and the International Kho Kho Federation.

About the event:

It will witness the participation of 24 countries from six continents, featuring 16 men's and 16 women's teams.

Significance:

- The Kho Kho World Cup aims to elevate this indigenous Indian sport to an international stage.
 - Kho Kho has its roots in India, and the World Cup will highlight the rich cultural heritage and competitive spirit of the sport.





The sport that started in the mud and now gone to the mat has a global presence with 54 countries playing the sport across the world.



Important Days/ Dates

International Day of Non-Violence

Why in the news?

It is celebrated annually on October 2 and marks the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

- History of this day:
 - It was proclaimed by the United Nations in 2007 and serves as a reminder of the power of nonviolence in shaping societies.
- * Significance of this day:
 - It serves as a global reminder of Mahatma Gandhi's enduring philosophy of peace and nonviolence.

- Celebrating Gandhi's legacy:
 - > Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Clean India Mission), launched in 2014, stands as one of the most significant initiatives reflecting Mahatma Gandhi's philosophy of cleanliness as essential to nation-building.
 - The Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) 2024 campaign, with its theme of 'Swabhaav Swachhata, Sanskaar Swachhata', was held from 17th September, 2024 to 1st October, 2024.
 - ✓ The campaign culminated with Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October,2024 marking the 10th anniversary of the Swachh Bharat Mission.
 - On September 11, 2024, Union Minister of Culture and Tourism, Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, inaugurated a special Railway Coach dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi at Gandhi Darshan, Rajghat, Delhi.
