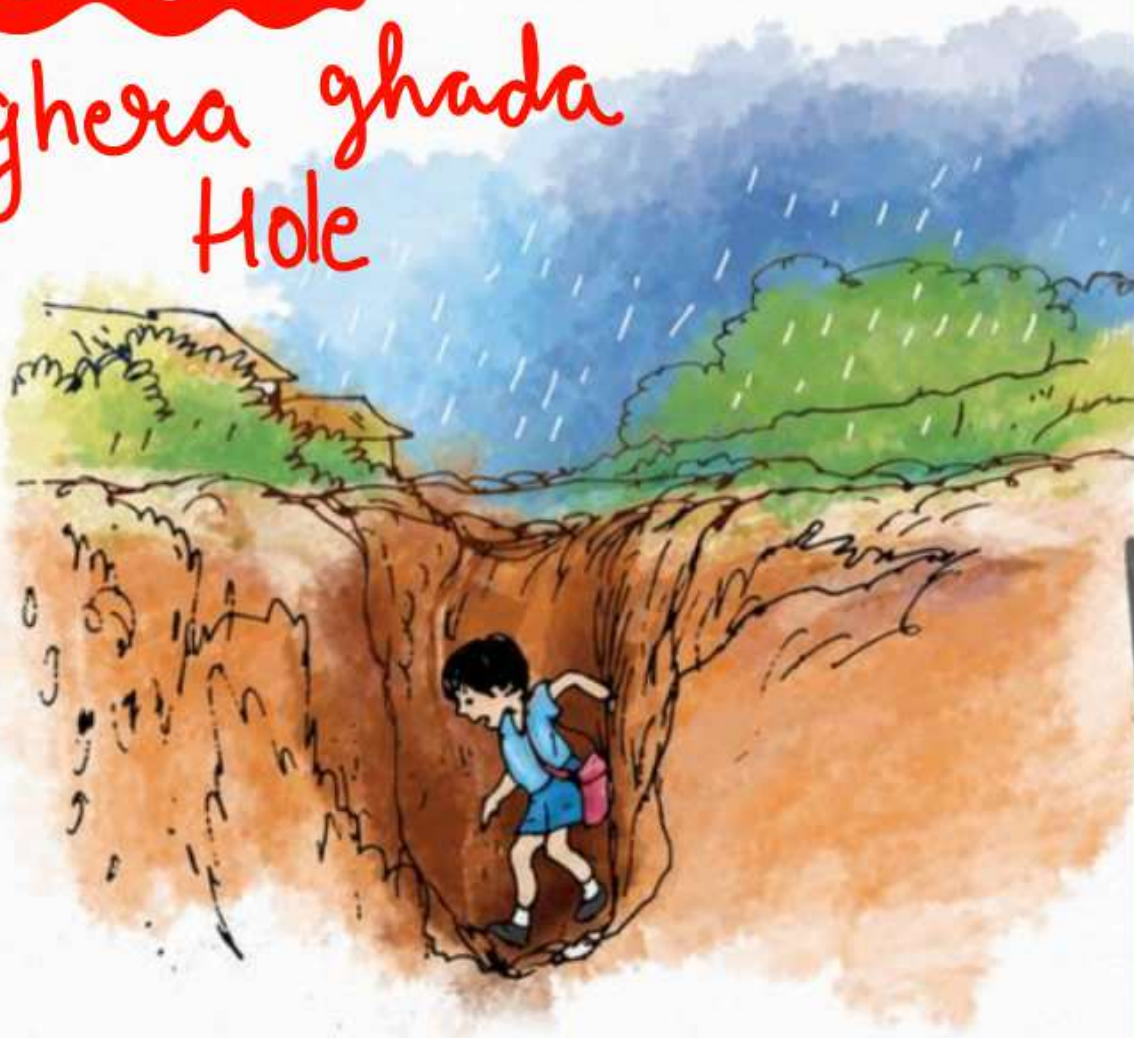

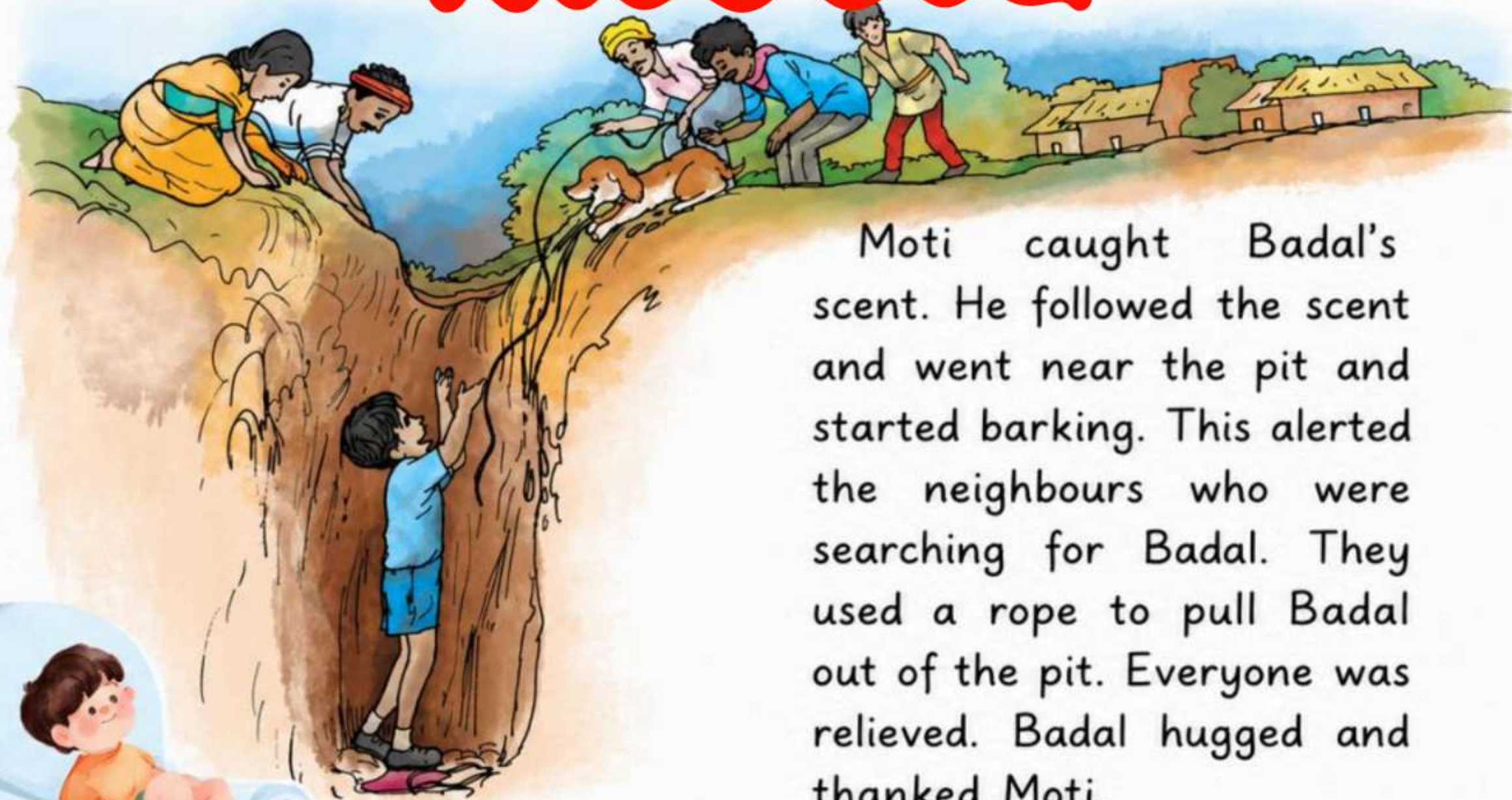
Badal and Moti
