

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

**PWNSAT (Physics Wallah National Scholarship cum Admission Test)** is a national-level examination conducted by Physics Wallah Ltd (PW) to identify, reward, and support meritorious students across India. PWNSAT will be conducted in two levels: PWNSAT Level-1 & PWNSAT Prodigy.

All awards and rewards shall be determined and disbursed only after the declaration of the respective PWNSAT results, in accordance with the applicable eligibility criteria and terms of the examination. In connection with the conduct of PWNSAT, PW may collect and process personal information during the registration process. By proceeding with the registration, you acknowledge and consent to such collection and processing of your personal data in accordance with the Company's Privacy Policy, available on the official website. The Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time at PW's discretion.

### 1. PWNSAT Registration & Procedure

- PWNSAT is offered in both Offline and Online modes, giving students the flexibility to choose the option that best suits them. Please note that once the mode of the test is selected, it cannot be changed. This ensures students have a convenient and comfortable experience during the exam, allowing them to focus on showcasing their knowledge and skills.
- Registration for both Offline and Online modes is available on the official PW website: {<https://www.pw.live/scholarship/vidyapeeth/nsat>} After registering, students can download their Admit Card for PWNSAT 2026 using their Registered Mobile Number.
- It is mandatory for the student to fill in all the required details as requested in the registration form. A student may register for and attempt PWNSAT Level-1 only once per academic year. Only one valid registration is permitted per student across Offline and Online modes. Duplicate, multiple, or registrations made using different details may be cancelled and may result in disqualification from PWNSAT and forfeiture of applicable benefits.
- After completing the registration process, students can proceed to attempt the mock practice papers available in the PW App.
- Any changes to Examination, Registration, or Result dates will be communicated to students through official channels only.

### 2. Examination Structure & Selection

- PWNSAT is conducted in two levels: PWNSAT Level-1 and PWNSAT Prodigy (Level-2). Eligibility for cash rewards, the free accommodation and education, and related benefits shall be determined based on the student's performance in PWNSAT Prodigy, subject to the criteria and conditions prescribed by PW.
- PWNSAT Level-1 scholarship examination will be conducted in School, Offline, and Online modes. PWNSAT Level-1 paper will consist of single-correct-answer questions and no negative marking. In Offline mode, the exam will be conducted on an OMR Sheet. In Online mode, the exam will be conducted on a device with a functional camera and a stable internet connection, and will be proctored. On the basis of the student's performance in Level-1, scholarships and the All India Rank (AIR) are determined.
- PWNSAT Prodigy is a single-day written examination scheduled to be conducted in November 2026. PWNSAT Prodigy will be conducted in offline mode at designated PW centers and the paper will include negative marking. The examination format and reporting details will be announced along with the Level-1 results / at the time of admit card release through the PW App/ Website, SMS, and also on WhatsApp.
- A student may qualify for PWNSAT Prodigy through either of the following routes:
  - Level-1 qualification** — students shortlisted on the basis of their PWNSAT Level-1 performance, as per the cutoff and criteria prescribed by PW; or
  - Principal Recommendation** — A duly signed Principal Recommendation Letter shall make the recommended student eligible for consideration for PWNSAT Prodigy, subject to verification and fulfillment of the eligibility criteria prescribed by PW.
- Students who qualify for PWNSAT Prodigy will be eligible for cash rewards, the residential program benefit (top 500 ranks), and other applicable benefits as per the designated reward structure.
- Any student found cheating or practicing any kind of malpractice during PWNSAT — including violation of proctoring rules in Online mode — will be promptly disqualified from the test and from any future opportunities.

### 3. Scholarship Criteria

The scholarship offered under PWNSAT Level-1 is applicable towards PW's 1-year and 2-year JEE/NEET Vidyapeeth Offline Courses.

- Students may be awarded scholarships of up to 100% of the course fee for the Academic Session **(2027–28)**, subject to PW Management's decision, based solely on the student's PWNSAT Level-1 performance and merit. The scholarship amount will be declared along with the PWNSAT Level-1 results.
- Students studying in **Classes 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> & Droppers** are eligible to apply for scholarships under PW JEE/NEET Offline Courses, subject to course eligibility criteria.
- PWNSAT scholarships are determined solely on the basis of the student's PWNSAT Level-1 performance and are applicable towards **tuition fees only**.

### 4. Cash Rewards Applicability (earned through PWNSAT Prodigy)

Cash rewards shall be awarded to students on the basis of their All India Rank (AIR) in PWNSAT Prodigy, class-wise and stream-wise (for Classes 10 to 12), as follows:

- Classes 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup>:** cash rewards up to AIR 150 for each class.
- Class 10<sup>th</sup>:** cash rewards up to AIR 500 in each stream (Medical & Engineering).
- Class 11<sup>th</sup>:** cash rewards up to AIR 300 in each stream (Medical & Engineering).
- Class 12<sup>th</sup> (Studying & Passed):** cash rewards up to AIR 50 in each stream (Medical & Engineering).

The applicable cash reward amount for each rank/rank-band shall be as per the reward structure prescribed by PW, communicated to eligible students along with the results.

**Disbursement schedule** — Cash rewards shall be disbursed in installments, linked to course progression:

**Note:** Cash rewards shall be disbursed in installments as per the schedule above, subject to fulfillment of all eligibility and admission requirements.

### 5. Cash Rewards Criteria (earned through PWNSAT Prodigy)

Cash rewards shall be awarded based on the All India Rank (AIR) secured in PWNSAT Prodigy, calculated separately for the applicable class and stream, as per the reward structure prescribed by PW.

**Tie-Breaker Rule:** In case the tie remains unresolved, preference may be given to students who have qualified in recognized national or international Olympiads, subject to verification of valid documentary proof:

- Higher rank will be awarded on the basis of subject-wise scores, in the following order of priority:
  - Classes 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>:** MAT, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
  - Classes 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> (JEE):** Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics.
  - Classes 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> (NEET):** Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology.
- If the aggregate score and all subject-wise scores of two or more students are identical, the younger student (by date of birth) shall be awarded the higher rank.
- Additionally, preference may be given to students who have qualified in recognized national or international Olympiads. Such students must provide valid documentary proof of their Olympiad qualification at the time of admission or verification.

### 6. Cash Rewards Eligibility (earned through PWNSAT Prodigy)

\*Students must meet all the minimum attendance, test participation, and cumulative test score criteria applicable to their class/stream.

- Applicability:** Cash rewards are applicable only to students enrolled in PW Vidyapeeth Offline Courses for Classes 7<sup>th</sup>–12<sup>th</sup> and Droppers (JEE/NEET), as per the prescribed reward structure. Students enrolled in Class 6<sup>th</sup> and below are not eligible under this scheme.

- b. Eligibility Criteria:** Students must fulfill the minimum attendance, test participation, and academic performance criteria specified in the table above. Only officially recorded attendance and scheduled test participation shall be considered.
- c. Verification of Eligibility:** Eligibility shall be verified by the Physics Wallah Vidyapeeth Academic Team. Any false information, malpractice, misconduct, or disciplinary violation may result in disqualification from the cash reward program.
- d. Reward Disbursement:** Cash rewards shall be disbursed in installments as per the distribution schedule in Section 6. For the first year, disbursement shall commence only after completion of three months from the course start date, subject to fulfillment of all eligibility requirements.
- e. Mode of Payment:** Cash rewards shall be transferred only through Cheque/NEFT to the student's bank account, or a joint account held with either parent (mother/father) in a nationalized or scheduled bank.
- f. Non-Transferability:** Scholarships and cash rewards are strictly non-transferable and cannot be exchanged, reassigned, or claimed by any other individual.
- g. Final Authority:** The decision of Physics Wallah Ltd regarding eligibility, verification, reward disbursement, interpretation of these terms, and all related matters shall be final and binding on all students and parents/guardians.
- 7. Free Accommodation and Education for Top Students**
- a. Eligibility:** A student shall be eligible for the free accommodation and education benefit only if the student secures a rank between 1 and 100 in his/her class in PWNSAT Level 1 and a rank between 1 and 100 in his/her class in PWNSAT Prodigy. Students satisfying both conditions shall be eligible for one (1) year of free accommodation and education at PW Vidyapeeth Residential Program (VPRP) campuses, subject to the discretion of Physics Wallah (PW).
- b. Discretionary Eligibility:** A student who is not ranked 1–100 in his/her class in PWNSAT Level 1 but secures a rank between 1 and 100 in his/her class in PWNSAT Prodigy may be considered for the benefit at the sole discretion of PW.
- c. Duration:** In all cases, an eligible student shall be entitled to one (1) year of free accommodation and education only.
- d. Verification of Eligibility:** Eligibility shall be verified by the Physics Wallah Vidyapeeth Academic Team. Any false information, malpractice, misconduct, or disciplinary violation may result in disqualification from the free accommodation and education benefit.
- e. Non-Transferability:** The offering is strictly non-transferable and cannot be exchanged, reassigned, or claimed by any other individual.
- f. Final Authority:** The decision of Physics Wallah Ltd regarding eligibility, verification, allotment of the free accommodation and education benefit, and all related matters shall be final and binding on all students and parents/guardians.
- g. Continuity of Benefit:** Continuation of the one-year free accommodation and education benefit is subject to the student meeting the following ongoing eligibility criteria. If the student fails to meet these criteria, PW reserves the right to cancel or discontinue the free accommodation and education benefit.

**8. Revocation of Cash Rewards and Scholarships**

- a.** At the time of enrollment in PW JEE/NEET Vidyapeeth Offline Courses, students must provide a valid school-issued marksheet, certificate, or other officially recognized document verifying the student's date of birth. Failure to submit the required documents may result in revocation of the scholarship and/or cash reward.
- b.** If, at any stage, it is found that a student has made multiple PWNSAT registrations using different details (including mobile numbers), PW reserves the right to revoke the scholarship and cash reward with immediate effect.
- c.** Any act of indiscipline or misconduct by the student during the course may result in revocation of scholarship and/or cash reward eligibility.
- d.** Absence from classes for more than two weeks without prior approval from the respective PW Vidyapeeth Centre Head may lead to revocation of the scholarship and cash reward eligibility.

## General Instructions

- a.** A scholarship is a fee concession provided to students as financial aid. If at any point the Government decides to charge GST or any other tax on the scholarship/concession/discount amount or awards & prizes, such tax shall be borne by the student/parent/guardian.
- b.** PWNSAT Level-1 scholarships are applicable towards **tuition fees only**. In the case of any special scholarship category, the scholarship amount may be applied to the overall fee, at the sole discretion of Physics Wallah Ltd (PW Ltd).
- c.** PWNSAT results, scholarship details, and eligibility information shall be communicated to students directly through SMS, WhatsApp, counselling calls, or other official communication channels.
- d.** To maintain fairness and credibility, the ranks of top-performing candidates in Level-1 (e.g., the top 50) will not be disclosed publicly, as Level-1 may be susceptible to malpractice. Final eligibility and rewards are determined on the basis of performance in **PWNSAT Prodigy**.
- e.** In case of any discrepancy in the PWNSAT 2026 result, the student may reach out to the nearest PW Vidyapeeth or PW Tuition Centre.
- f.** It is compulsory to provide the mobile number of the student, parent, or guardian. Results and other information will be sent via SMS, WhatsApp, Call, or push notification. PW may use the contact details provided during registration to communicate information relating to PWNSAT, including examination updates, results, counselling, scholarship information, and other relevant program-related communications, in accordance with its Privacy Policy and applicable law.
- g.** Scholarships and cash rewards under PWNSAT are applicable only to students who enrol in PW's 1-year or 2-year JEE/NEET Offline Courses.
- h.** Existing/Internal PW students are not eligible to participate in the scholarship and cash reward program under PWNSAT, unless explicitly specified by PW under a separate category or policy.
- i.** Students availing PWNSAT scholarships shall remain eligible to appear for other scholarship examinations conducted by PW, including SAT and similar programs, subject to the respective terms and conditions of such examinations. The applicability, adjustment, or combination of benefits arising from multiple scholarship programs shall be determined solely by PW.
- j.** A student may register for and attempt PWNSAT Level-1 only once per academic year. Only one valid registration is permitted per student across Offline and Online modes. Duplicate, multiple, or registrations made using different details may be cancelled and may result in disqualification from PWNSAT and forfeiture of applicable benefits.
- k.** The scholarship shall remain valid for the period specified by PW in the scholarship communication. PW reserves the right to modify the validity period in accordance with the applicable scholarship terms.
- l.** By agreeing, you authorize the Physics Wallah Ltd. to use your name, photos, and videos for publicity across all media. PWNSAT also reserves the right to record video and audio testimonials before or after the exam for promotional purposes.
- m.** In case any dispute or difference arises between the student/parent and the Institute regarding the interpretation of these terms and conditions, non-payment of any claim, or any matter arising out of or under these terms, the same shall be referred to a sole arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of the parties. The proceedings shall be conducted at Delhi under the provisions of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, and the Courts at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction. If the appointed arbitrator refuses or is unable to act, or the proceedings are abandoned, the parties may, by mutual consent, appoint another arbitrator, who shall be entitled to proceed from the stage at which the proceedings were left, subject to both parties' consent.
